

# Fatality at Lonmin's K3 Shaft



**Marikana** – Lonmin Plc announced the death of Mr Giji Mxesibe (49), Rock Drill Operator, in an accident at the Company's K3 shaft on Friday, 17 February 2017. Mr Mxesibe's family has been informed and is receiving support from the company. "We extend our deepest condolences to his family, colleagues and friends," the Lon-

min statement read. From the preliminary investigation, it appears that Mr Mxesibe drilled into a misfired hole and sustained fatal injuries. Two other employees sustained minor injuries. The area where the incident occurred will remain closed until the investigation is completed by the Tripartite of the DMR, AMCU and Lonmin.

## N4 claims a Life

**Rustenburg** – "One man was killed and two others were injured early Sunday morning, 19 February 2017 when a bakkie t-boned a light motor vehicle on the N4 near the Kroonvaal turn-off in Rustenburg," Russel Meiring, ER24 spokesperson, said. ER24 paramedics, along with another emergency service, arrived on the scene to find the bakkie in the middle of the road while the light motor vehicle was found on the side of the road.

Upon closer inspection, paramedics found the body of a

man lying in the light motor vehicle showing no signs of life. Unfortunately, nothing could be done for the man and he was declared dead on scene.

The two occupants of the bakkie, a man and woman, were assessed. They both sustained moderate injuries. Paramedics treated the patients and thereafter transported them to a nearby hospital for further treatment.

The cause of the collision is not yet known but local authorities were on scene for further investigations.

## 2.2% Electricity Hike from 1 April 2017

The National Energy Regulator (NERSA) at its meeting held on Thursday, 23 February 2017, confirmed Eskom's allowable revenue of R205 214 million for the last year of the MYPD3 period (2017/18 financial year). The allowed revenue will result in a percentage increase of 2.2% due to the base adjustments made in the preceding years as a result of the approved Regulatory Clearing Account (RCA) balances for Eskom (12.7% for 2015/16 and 9.4% for 2016/17). This means that consumers'

electricity bills will increase with 2.2% as from 1 April 2017. The Energy Regulator confirmed the allowable revenues on the basis of the approved MYPD3 revenues and average price for 2017/18. The allowed revenue for 2017/18 is Eskom's full year's revenue as determined in the MYPD3 decision. The allowed revenue will be able to cover all of Eskom's allowed costs, plus a return to the value of R33 667m as per the MYPD3 decision.
