Mooienooi – On Tuesday, 28 March 2017, the Walk for Hope team took their first steps at 07h00 from Hammanskraal. They made their way to Mooienooi at approximately 13h00 on Wednesday, where the Grace Help Centre hosted the team. After 325 km in total – by foot – the team arrived at Mafikeng on Saturday, 1 April 2017 at 15:00 PM.

The Walk for Change event was initiated by Angie Diale 3 years ago. She was inspired by 16 Days of Activism against child and woman abuse, to connect to a group with same interests. They are now a dynamic group of entrepreneurs and social activists for change.

With the Walk for Hope, Diale aims to inspire, mentor and establish a skills hub and to be a source for charities for items such as school shoes, sanitary pads,

bedding, soccer kits, squeeze bottles, clothing and bedding.

The main objective of the initiative is to establish an entrepreneurial hub in the North-West Province, which will provide learners with the opportunity to grow their minds and be provided with the skills and mentoring to thrive and become economy developers. With the walk, they aim to get the attention of corporate sponsors to come onboard to help sponsor the above-mentioned items and with each sponsorship, each corporate can challenge a supplier or partner in their industry to identify and establish a school feeding program.


As Diale feels a learner can't concentrate on an empty stomach.
