Please assist in identifying decapitated woman

Kroondal – In the early morning hours of Tuesday, 2 May 2017, a 54-year old decapitated and decomposed woman was found in the Kroondal area, on the Dinie Estates turn-off, about 500m from the Old Pretoria road.

A school bag containing an ID of a friend of the deceased was found in her possession. The friend has since been located in Fauresmith, Free State.

The friend of the deceased informed the investigating officer that they attended a church service in Rustenburg on 26 March 2017. The next day the two friends met at the Rustenburg taxi rank to return home. The 54-year old African woman went to the ladies' toilets to freshen up. When the taxi was ready to leave, her friend phoned her, but to no avail. She took the taxi to Bloemfontein thinking her friend would get on the next taxi.

Since then, DNA samples were obtained from family members of the deceased in order to confirm her identity.

Rustenburg – A second decapitated body of a woman was discovered by pedestrians on Monday, 8 May 2017, at about 08h00 in a water trench in Buiten Street on the outskirts of Rustenburg, leading to the R510.

The identity of the woman is still unknown. Forensic analysis has been done to determine the identity of the deceased. She was decapitated and her right hand cut off. Photos of the deceased woman, herewith, are extended in an effort to help with identification. The woman was in her early twenties and of African origin.

“We are appealing to the public to come forward with information which might assist us to eventually bring these brutal killers to book,” Captain Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson said.

3 MALES SENTENCED FOR RAPE

Rustenburg/ Tlhabane – Freddy Gift Dube (26) and Itumeleng Monatong Mekgwe (25) were found guilty on charges of rape and armed robbery, on Wednesday, 24 May 2017, before the Bafokeng Regional court in Tlhabane.


According to Sgt Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson, both assailants were sentenced to life imprisonment for rape. They were handed another further fifteen year jail sentence for armed robbery. The sentences are running concurrently.

The pair attacked, robbed and raped a 48-year old woman, on her way home from work in Lefaragatha on 21 August 2015. With the help of a scholar, who heard the woman's screams, the Police managed to arrest the assailants within minutes of the crime.

In an unrelated case, Steven Dimakatso Rakhudu (36) from Tsitsing was found guilty on the charge of rape before the Tlhabane Regional Court. He raped a 13-year old girl in 2015.

The assailant was sentenced to an effective ten years jail term. His name is also listed on the national register for sex offenders.

The Rustenburg cluster commander Major General Adams welcomed the convictions adding that credit must go to the Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual offence Unit and especially Sergeant Ernest Modise, whose hard work and commitment played a crucial role in securing a conviction in both cases. “We hope that the victims and their families will derive strength from the fact that those who inflicted such a painful experience in their lives stay in jail for a long time,” General Adams said.
