BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF DIESEL TANKS, DEVELOPMENT OF AN ACCESS ROAD AND RAILWAY EXTENSIONS AT AMANDELBULT COMPLEX IN AMANDELBULT MINE TOWN, LIMPOPO PROVINCE

Notice is given in terms of regulation 41(2) of GNR 326 (7 April 2017) published under sections 24 and 24(D) of the National Environmental Management Act (No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) for the submission of an application for an environmental authorisation (EA) in respect of an activity identified under GNR 324 (7April 2017)

BACKGROUND AND LOCATION

The applicant, Rustenburg Platinum Mines Limited (RPM), operate an existing underground fuel tank site which is used to support the mining operations. RPM intends to install two 30 m3 aboveground diesel storage tanks on an existing bund that is about 40 m to the south of the underground tanks. These additional tanks are required due to the upcoming open casts. The additional tanks will be used in the event that the underground tanks run dry. RPM also proposes to extend its railway lines, add a chromium loading area (7 500 m2) along this extension and an access road (110 m by 6 m) that leads to this loading area.

The site is located within the Amandelbult complex in Amandelbult Mine Town, Limpopo province.

ENVIRONMENTAL APPLICATION

Listed Activity 4 of Listing Notice 3 (2017 Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations) is triggered by the proposed project. The listed activity reads as follows: "The development of a roadwider than 4 metres with areserve less than 13,5 metres." (a) In Limpopo province: Outside urban areas in: (ee) Critical biodiversity areas as identified in systematic biodiversity plans adopted by the competent authority or in bioregional plans.

Listed Activity 10 of Listing Notice 3 (2017 Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations) is triggered by the proposed project. The listed activity reads as follows: "The development and related operation of facilities or infrastructure for the storage, orstorage and handling of adangerous good, where such storage occurs in containers with a combined capacity of 30 but not exceeding 80 cubic metres." (e) In Limpopo: (i) All areas.

Regulation 31 process is to be followed for the proposed railway extensions. This regulation reads as follows: "An environmental authorisation may be amended by following the process prescribed in thisPart if the amendment will result in a change to the scope of a valid environmental authorisation wheresuch change will result in an increased level or nature of impact where such level or nature of impactwas not– (b) taken into consideration in the initial environmental authorisation" and the change does not, on its own, constitute a listed or specified activity.
