

Sgt Gift Kelehe, 3rd in the Comrades Marathon

Pretoria – A member of the Police, Sergeant Gift Kelehe, originally from the North West province, attained 3rd place in the 92nd Comrades Marathon on Sunday 4 June 2017 in Kwazulu-Natal.

Sergeant Kelehe, 35, was previously posted at the Tactical Response Team in Rustenburg. He is currently working at the Police Service Tshwane Academy under the Division: Human Resource Development. He has served the South African community diligently for the past 13 years. This North West local was born and grew up at Sekhing Village, Taung in the North West Province.

Sergeant Kelehe is a sports fanatic who started running the Comrades Marathon in 2007 at the age of 25, when he crossed the finish-line in 40th place. The motivated and disciplined sergeant continued to train and participate in this and other races. In 2015 Kelehe, then a Constable, won the prestigious Comrades marathon, after coming third in 2014.
