GESIN VERLOOR ALLES IN BRAND

Rustenburg – 'n Rustenburg familie se huis het Sondagaand, 11 Junie 2017 afgebrand totdat net die leë dop oor is. Hendrik du Plessis het saam met sy 1-jarige dogtertjie, 4-jarige seuntjie en vriendin Karen Barnard by Kockstraat 30A gebly toe die brand uitbreek waarin hulle al hulle besittings verloor het.

Die gesin se huishulp het ook tesame met haar 2 kinders in die buitekamer gebly, maar die kamer het gelukkig nie gebrand nie. Die 3 honde en 2 katte kon genadiglik ook gered word.

Die brandweer beweer dat daar 'n kortsluiting in die sitkamer was, waarskynlik veroorsaak deur die muurproppe of bedrading. "Ons het net dadelik almal uit die huis uit gevlug en toe al ons diere ook gekry. Ons weet nog nie wat beloop die skade nie," sê Du Plessis. Die gesin het nie versekerings gehad nie.

Die gesin het dadelik die polisie gebel, maar het nie die brandweer se nommer gehad nie. Die bure en ander mense wie kom help het, het egter die brandweer gebel, maar hulle het eers dertig minute later opgedaag.

"Dit was glad nie 'n lekker ervaring nie. Ons was baie bang. Ons is net dankbaar dat almal veilig is en niemand beseer was nie. Dit is tog al wat saak maak. Ons wil graag baie dankie sê vir almal wat die aand daar was en ons ondersteun het, en ook aan al die mense wat ons nou bystaan en help; baie dankie," sê Du Plessis.

Die gemeenskap het op die StaanSaam Rustenburg Facebook blad saamgetrek en gevra vir donasies vir hierdie gesin in hulle uur van nood. 

Three severely injured in house fire

Rustenburg/ Tlhabane – On Tuesday, 13 June 2017 at about 01h00 in the morning, three people were severely injured in a house fire at Tlhabane, opposite the Tlhabane sports grounds.

A woman, Monica Shalwane, 12-year old Katlego Shalwane and their visitor sustained severe burn wounds. The three were taken to hospital for medical care.

A family spokesperson told the Platinum Weekly newspaper that it is alleged arson was the cause of the fire as a cloth filled with gasoline was discovered beneath the door. "The entire house smelled like petrol," he said. The Police were on scene and investigations are underway.

ANGRY MOB SET ALIGHT SUNRISE VIEW CLINIC

Rustenburg/ Boitekong – An angry mob set alight the Sunrise View Clinic in Boitekong on Friday night, 9 June 2017.

Spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides said in a statement that disgruntled community members of Sunrise Park gathered and blocked the roads in the vicinity of the Mpho Khunou Squatter camp and pelted motorists' vehicles with stones.

At about 22h00 at night, they moved to the local clinic and held two security guards hostage and took their cell phones. The gate to

the clinic was forcefully opened and about ten African males gained entry to the premises, broke the windows and set the clinic alight. After the clinic was burnt, the suspects handed the security personnel their phones back and allowed them to go free. The suspects then fled the scene on foot. The reason for setting the clinic alight is still unknown. Cases of malicious damage to property and arson are currently being investigated. The Cluster Commander, Major-General Adams, has condemned this act of violence. "Innocent women and children, as well as the elderly will suffer without much needed medical care as a result of this senseless act of public violence, which will not be tolerated."
