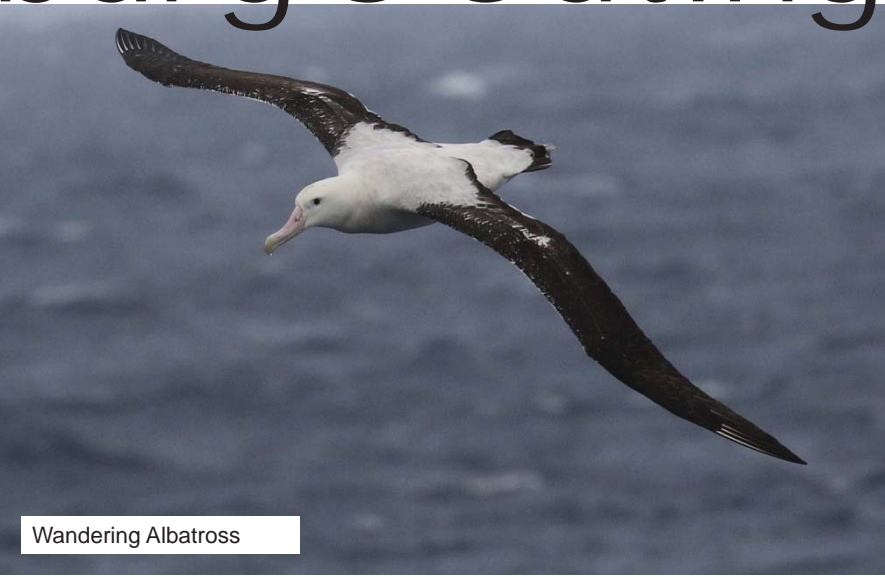


# BirdLife Rustenburg's Outing

**Rustenburg** – BirdLife Rustenburg's June outing will be held on Saturday, 24 June 2017, and will be at the Hartebeespoort area. The guys will meet at the BP Garage, Waterfall Mall, at 06h30 and will then proceed to the Aloe Farm in Harties. Here the flowering Aloes will provide sightings of the many Sunbirds that gather there to feed on the Aloe nectar. These should include White Bellied, Marico, Amethyst and possibly Greater Double Collared Sunbirds. From here they will move to Vulpro where they can witness the Vulture feeding programme, Cape Vultures (wild) and other rehabilitated birds. Bring along drinks, snacks and warm clothing! There is an entrance fee of R60 per person. They will return home at about 14h00. Should there be interest; BirdLife Rustenburg will also have the option of visiting the nearby Cycad Nursery where more Sunbirds and Cape

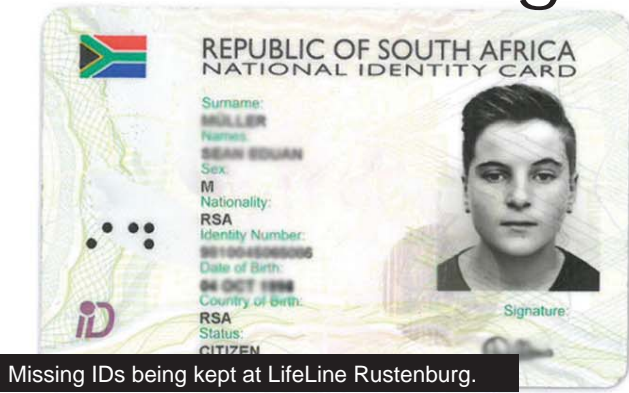

## ELUSIVE CRIMINAL WOUNDED AFTER A HIGH SPEED CHASE

**Rustenburg/ Phokeng** – A dangerous criminal was wounded on Wednesday, 7 June 2017, at about 16h30 in Phokeng, while attempting to escape arrest by the Police. The Police responded to a circulated radio message requesting them to assist in the arrest of a suspect who is wanted for attempted murder in a Mogwase case. The suspect's silver Toyota RunX was spotted in Kanana by members of the TRT in the vicinity of the R510 near Boitekong. The Flying Squad members responded to the message and intercepted the vehicle,

but the suspect was adamant to flee from the Police. Various attempts were made to get the suspect to pull over, but the suspect persisted in fleeing in the direction of Impala 6 shaft. A high-speed chase ensued and the man recklessly continued to drive at a high speed until he collided sideways into a private vehicle. The suspect jumped from his vehicle and fled into the veld. TRT and Flying Squad members gave chase. According to information the suspect was armed. The Police fired shots and the suspect was wounded in the right thigh. He

is currently under Police guard in a local hospital. "A follow-up operation ensued and an illegal firearm, a 9mm Norinco pistol, was discovered in the suspect's hide-out in Luka. The suspect will appear in court once he is fit to stand trial," captain Elsabe Augoustides, police spokesperson, said. The suspect faces prosecution on the current attempted murder case, as well as reckless and negligent driving and the illegal possession of a firearm.
