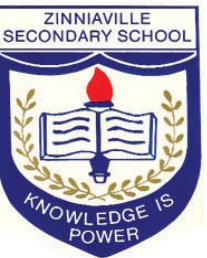


Zinniaville hockey boys miss out on gold

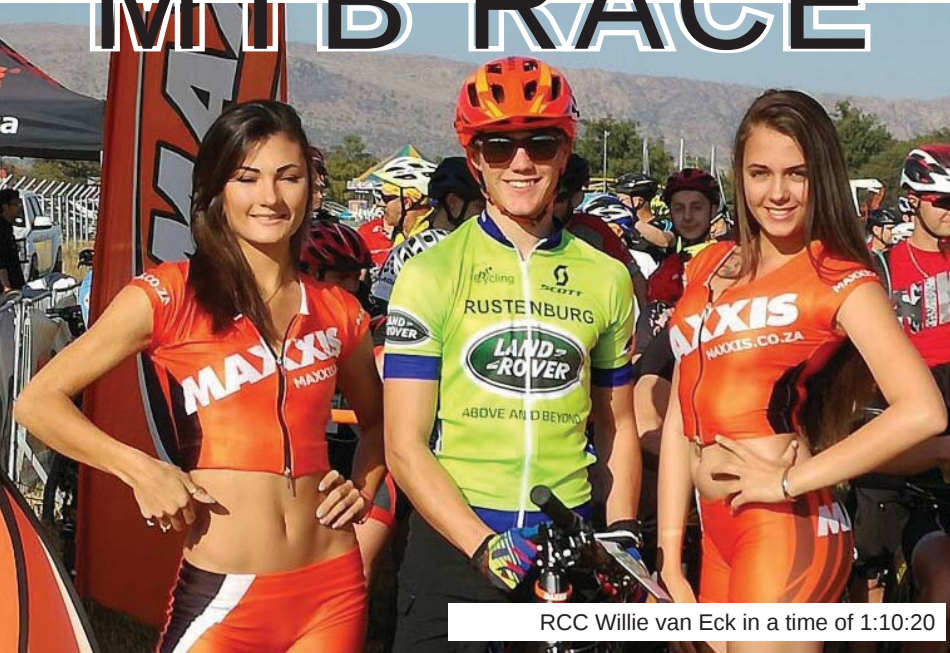

MAXXIS MTB RACE

Rustenburg – The inaugural Maxxis MTB Race took place on Saturday, 17 June 2017, at Steineck Lodge just outside Rustenburg. Cyclists had to choose between the 10km, 30km or the 60km marathon race. Several members from the Rustenburg Cycling Club (RCC) participated in this tough event which took riders around the Kroondal area.

The 30km race was won by RCC Willie van Eck in a time of 1:10:20. Willie and other members from the Rustenburg Cycling Academy used this event to prepare for the SA MTB championships: XCO/DHI, which takes place at the Mankele Mountain Bike Park outside Nelspruit.

IRONMAN 70.3

Rustenburg – On Sunday, 18 June 2017, a number of fearless souls from the RCC took part in the annual Iron Man 70.3 in Durban.

This very tough event in the heart of the paradise city begins with a 1.9km swim in the Bay of Plenty, followed by a fast, undulating 90km bike course that loops around the Blue Lagoon and heads along the M4 highway. The flat, 21km two-loop run course along the promenade provided some fast times along with some spectacular views.

The day started with calm seas with a rolling start at 7.20am. Seven athletes took off every five seconds! After the swim, there was a short run on the beach to transition where 3 000 athletes scrambled to put on their cycling kit then an 800m run out of transition to the start of the 90km cycle!

The athletes couldn't have asked for better weather, overcast and almost no wind. The cycle

took the athletes out on the M3 all the way to the second Zimbali circle then back to Durban for a short loop then back to the Sun Coast Casino where the bikes were quickly racked and quick gear change to start the flat 21km run along Durban's notorious golden mile! After the two laps the athletes were given a hero's welcome on the red carpet buy the enthusiastic Iron Man crew!

Members from Rustenburg Cycling Club excelled in the event and completed the race in personal record times:

- Christa Venter: Swim - 00:42:59, Bike - 3:02:18 and Run - 02:43:16 Overall Time: 06:42:16
- Sharon O Reilly: Swim - 00:39:33, Bike - 2:59:50 and Run - 02:31:32 Overall Time: 06:26:02 - Finished 15th out of 39 participants in her age group!
- Richard Roos: 00:37:33, Bike - 2:54:51 and Run - 02:16:45 Overall Time: 05:58:35
