Three killed, seven injured in N4 collision

Rustenburg/ Brits – Three people were killed and seven others sustained injuries during a collision between a taxi and a BMW on the N4 between Brits and Rustenburg, on Sunday 2 July 2017. At approximately 15h30 paramedics from ER24, Trauma Rescue and other services arrived on the scene where they found both vehicles down an embankment several meters into a veld. Several occupants from the taxi were ejected.

A toddler believed to be about two years old was also found with moderate injuries. Two people were found near the taxi with fatal injuries. Sadly, there was nothing that paramedics could do for them and they were declared dead on the scene, according to ER24 representatives. A passenger from the BMW sustained fatal injuries.

The remaining patients on the scene were treated for various injuries and transported to nearby hospitals for further care.

The exact circumstances surrounding the collision are not yet known. The N4 direction west was closed off for some time while police attended the scene for investigations.

WRECKAGE FOUND BY QUAD BIKE RIDERS, TWO DEAD

Rustenburg – Two people, a man and a woman, were found with fatal injuries after their car crashed along the N4 between Dr Moroka Drive and the R565 in Rustenburg on Saturday, 1 July 2017.

At approximately 14h00 the afternoon, paramedics from ER24 arrived on the scene where they found the vehicle lying several meters down an embankment next to the highway. The wreckage was found by a group of quad bike riders. They came across the two people inside the vehicle and alerted emergency services.

Paramedics assessed the man and woman and declared that they have been dead for some time. They were declared dead on the scene.

"It is understood from another emergency services company that they responded to reports of a crash near the same area at 02h 00 that morning, but were unable to find any signs of a crash. It is not clear if the wreckage found by the quad bike riders is the same crash," Russel Meiring, ER24 spokesperson, said.

The circumstances surrounding the crash are not yet known. Local police attended the scene and investigations continue.

N4 ACCIDENT CLAIMS TWO

Rustenburg/ Phokeng – An accident on the N4 on Saturday, 1 July 2017, around 15h30 claimed the lives of two people.

The accident occurred a few meters from the Phokeng off-ramp as a white Audi A5 with two occupants overturned and ended up under a bridge.

"It is alleged that the driver, a 29-year old male, appeared to have lost control of the vehicle. He was declared dead on scene. His female passenger (22) was also declared dead on scene," Sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson, said.

The Police are investigating a case of culpable homicide.

High speed chase lead to arrest

Rustenburg – The Police in Rustenburg apprehended a 36-year old man on Saturday, 1 July 2017, in Waterfall East after a high speed car chase.

"The police were on patrol to maintain visibility when they spotted a suspicious-looking silver BMW outside a bank. The police approached the driver who then sped off. A high speed car chase ensued," Captain Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson, said.

The suspect and his three accomplices were found at a residential complex in Waterfall East, according to reports. The three

accomplices managed to flee and evaded the arrest. The fourth suspect was arrested and three pistols, ammunition, balaclavas and gloves were seized.

A preliminary investigation revealed that the suspect's vehicle had been rented from Klerksdorp and the original number plate had been replaced by false registration number plates by the time of the incident. A case of illegal possession of firearms and ammunition has been registered.

The suspect appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Tuesday, 4 July 2017.
