



Violent protest – N4 closed

Majakaneng/ Mooinooi – The N4 near Majakaneng (near Mooinooi and Brits) was closed from Sunday, 13 August, due to violent protests. At the time of going to press, the N4 highway is still closed off (17 August 2017). The protests came about as a call to action to the Police regarding an incident in which a 24-year old man was allegedly shot and injured by a local farmer on Wednesday, 2 August 2017, after he and two other men were allegedly found stealing oranges from his farm. The 24-year old man was never seen since that day, and the incident was reported to the Police two days later. The Police are requesting members of the community in and around Majakaneng as well as

Mooinooi to assist with any information that may shed light on this missing person enquiry and attempted murder case registered at the Mooinooi police station. "The Police are working hard to investigate and get to the bottom of the matter. However, it is clear now that criminals have started to damage properties and targeting passing motorists whose vehicles are pelted with stones. The community is warned to refrain from criminal acts as that will not be tolerated and that drastic action will be taken against anyone who commits crime," Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, police spokesperson, said. Rustenburg – On Friday 11 August in the morning hours between 09:00-10:00 on the corners of Watsonia road and Dr Moroka Drive near the Kloof, a car accident claimed the lives of two people. "There were two vehicles involved, a Mercedes sedan and a Fidelity security kombi. There was one person in the Mercedes and six people in the Fidelity vehicle. Sadly, two Fidelity security personnel died on the scene. Five patients were hospitalized, sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson, said. We extend our sincerest condolences to the families and friends those involved.
