

Conquering the SA high schools champs

Rustenburg – On Friday, 4 August, Curro Aurora held a simple credo for the SA high school championship: the tournament is never won or lost until the last putt drops! It was this conviction and a strong team spirit that steered Woo-Ju Son, Kieron van Wyk, Cole Stevens and Carl Mwale into the winner's circle at the Rustenburg Golf Club on a winning score of even-par 432. Two-time Curro SA juniors international girls champion Son guided the team into the early attack with a three-under-par 69 in the first round. Kieron van Wyk carded a 71 and fellow GolfRSA national squad player Cole Stevens added a 73 for a three-under-par 213 to lay the foundation for their success. The side headed into the final round with a narrow one-shot lead over Glenwood House and a five-shot lead over Grey College Secondary. Under pressure from the charging pack, Son, Van Wyk and Carl Mwale – another member of the GolfRSA National Squad – produced three superb rounds of 73 for a total of 219 that sealed their victory. Meanwhile Jean Pierre van der Watt (69), Bradley de Beer (74) and Alex van Wyk (76) from Glenwood House also combined for 219 to finish a close second on 433. Samuel McKenzie fired a seven-under-par 65 to rocketed Tuks Sport High School

into contention and Nicholas Souranis (71) and Francois Janse van Rensburg (77) sealed third place for the two-time former champions on 441. However, none the 12 competitors in the leading three teams could match the brilliance of Wilco Nienaber from Grey College Secondary in the individual competition. The reigning Curro SA juniors international boys champion blistered the par 72 layout with two successive rounds of 65 to claim the individual honour on 14-under-par 130. The GolfRSA National Squad player finished eight shots clear of McKenzie, while Van der Watt took third at three under and 2017 nomads sa girls champion Son finished fourth at two under. Recent Dimension Data Junior Open U-15 challenge winner Nash de Klerk from the GED Academy signed off with a 72 to grab a share of fifth at even-par 144 with Van Wyk and Stals Swart from the Afrikaans Hoërskool vir Seuns, who closed with a 74.

- Hoërskool Rustenburg ended with a score of 452. Barend van Zyl, 72 Ray Janse van Rensburg, 73 and Hendrik Naude 80 ending with 225; and 227 for Ray Janse van Rensburg 73 Barend van Zyl 75 Hendrik Naude 79. Ray Janse van Rensburg also obtained a joint 7th place in the individual top 10.

Karatekas, get grappling!

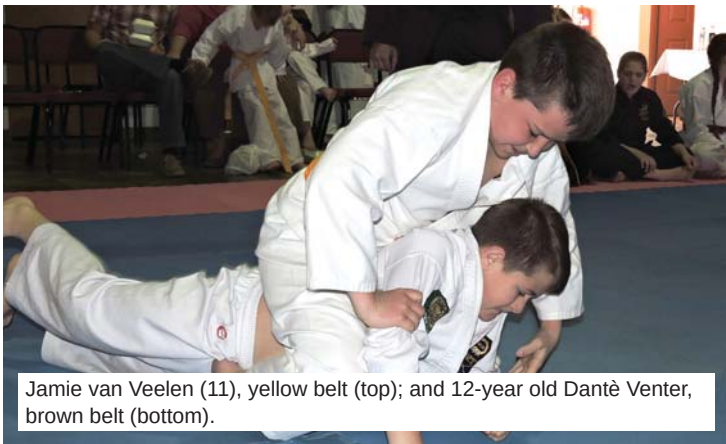
