MTB buffs gear up for provincial final

Rustenburg – As the last leg of the Spur Schools MTB League gets underway, mountain biking enthusiasts are gearing-up for North West final at Hoërskool Rustenburg on 2 September.

Riders have been out in their droves every weekend since May, representing their schools and working extra hard to earn their place in the regional final.

Regional event coordinator Deon Steyn says: "We are so proud to be a part of something that changes the lives of school children by keeping them active and focused. We're certain the League and the North West regional participation will continue to grow from strength to strength in the years to come."

The top performing schools for the region are: Hoërskool Rustenburg, Wagpos, Potchefstroom Gimnasium, Hartbeespoort, and Wesvalia. The riders from these schools will battle it out to qualify and represent their schools at the Spur MTB League Inter-schools Final on 7-8 October in Magaliesburg at Bekker High School. Here, schools will go head-to-head on race day and the race moves away from the individual rider-focus to a team-focussed race. Each school strives to qualify for this part of League.

A cash prize of R10 000 is up for grabs and will be awarded to each school at the top of their age category. The primary and high schools finishing top of the points log at the end of each season are awarded the Region's School Champion floating trophy.

As the pioneer of SA's MTB schools league, the Spur Schools MTB initiative is today the country's largest high school cycling programme and main nursery for talent in the sport. There are currently 493 participating schools delivering more than 10 500 entries into 46 regional events across 9 provinces. Every year since its inception, the Spur Schools Mountain Bike League achieves a 10% growth.

Both events will start at 07h00 at Rustenburg Kloof and will follow routes from the Kloof into the Kgaswane reserve and back to the Kloof. A new challenge to endurance athletes: complete both the 25 km run and the 60 km mountain bike ride and earn a unique Kgaswane Extreme Challenge medal!

The running mountain race will take place on Saturday 2 September and runners will have a choice of three distances: 5, 10 or 25 km. The MTB is on Sunday 3 September, also with three distances: 15, 35 or 60 km. All finishers of the running and cycling events will receive race medals.
