



## Two bakkies collide on the R24

**Rustenburg** – Three men were injured on Tuesday morning, 5 September, one of them critically, when two bakkies collided head-on on the R24 between Krugersdorp and Rustenburg.

ER24 paramedics, along with other emergency services, arrived on the scene and found the bakkies on the side of the road, each on the opposite side of the roadside barriers. Upon closer inspection, paramedics discovered one man seated inside one bakkie while two men were found seated inside the second bakkie. The passenger was trapped inside his vehicle.

Rescue services had to use Jaws of Life equipment to free the man from the vehicle. One of the drivers was in a critical condition



while the second driver and passenger had sustained minor to moderate injuries.

Paramedics treated the patients and provided the critically injured man with advanced life support interventions. Once the patients were treated, they were transported to a nearby hospital for advanced treatment. The

critically injured man was airlifted by a private medical helicopter to a nearby hospital for further care. The cause of the collision is not yet known but local authorities were on the scene for further investigations.

## Rapist sentenced to a lengthy jail term



**Mogwase** – The fight against gender based violence by Mogwase Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences Unit (FCS) is continuously yielding successes. Warrant Officer Letsie Kgaboesele managed to secure another hefty sentence for rape.

On Friday 25 August, Sam Nxumalo (44) was sentenced to a 25 years' imprisonment sentence by the Mankwe Regional court in Mogwase after he forced himself on a 12-year old minor during 2015 in Ledig near Sun City. It is alleged that Nxumalo, who was the victim's neighbour at the time, lured the victim to his rented room during the day and then raped her.

"He was arrested the same year in June and granted bail, but never attended court again. Extensive and excellent investigation skills by warrant officer Letsie Kgaboesele led to the re-arrest of Nxumalo in 2016 and he has been in custody ever since," sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson said.

The Rustenburg cluster commander general Arthur Adams applauded warrant officer Kgaboesele and the Mogwase FCS unit for their relentless efforts in ensuring that the accused was re-arrested and convicted.
