Copper cable bust

Rustenburg – “The Rustenburg Police arrested three suspects for the illegal possession of copper cable,” sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson, said. The bust took place at the Bokamoso informal settlement near Rustenburg after the Police received information that copper cable was being prepared for transportation. Upon arrival the Police came across a 21-year old woman and two men, aged 34 and 41, busy peeling off plastic from the copper cables. They could not account for the copper in their possession and were arrested. The three suspects also face charges of drug possession after the Police confiscated cultivated dagga plants from the premises. The suspects appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 14 September.

Community kills alleged rapist

Rustenburg/ Boitekong – During the early hours of Saturday 2 September, a half-naked, lifeless body of a beloved local 21-year old woman with visible head injuries was discovered in Boitekong. “A member of the community found the woman and later summoned the Police. On arrival the community had already apprehended the alleged suspect and were busy assaulting him.

The responding Police vehicle tried to intervene but the community members flatly refused to hand over the 25-year old suspect,” sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson, said. Police backup was called in and successfully managed to assist. The suspect was taken to a local hospital where he succumbed to his injuries on Monday 11 September. Investigations continue.

Suspect linked to 18 serious offences

Rustenburg – An efficient utilisation of resources in the investigation of crime paid off when a 29-year old accused, Sipho Thomas Mdiniso was linked to approximately 18 serious offences. “At the time of the discovery, the accused was in detention for a case of assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm. As part of investigations and through the utilisation of investigative aids, the hardworking Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences Unit (FCS) in Rustenburg managed to link the accused with 18 offences. They include seven rape offences, eight house robberies and rapes, one murder, one motor vehicle theft and one common robbery,” brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone,

police spokesperson, said. The offences were committed between 2010 and 2016 in Boitekong and Tlhabane. The suspect appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 7 September, and the case was postponed until Tuesday, 19 September for the centralisation of the cases. The North West provincial commissioner, lieutenant general Baile Motswenyane commended members for making sure that serial offenders such as this one are arrested. She said further that the arrest will serve as a warning that the Police will leave no stone unturned in ensuring that those who commit crime are brought to book.
