# Three die in two accidents

**Rustenburg** – “A tragic accident occurred on Monday evening, 25 September, at approximately 18h00 in East End Rustenburg,” captain Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson said. One man in the vehicle, who hails from Zimbabwe, passed away due to the injuries he sustained in the crash.

In a second vehicle accident near Rustenburg, a car crashed into a tree killing two and injuring four on Sunday, 24 September. Two men were killed and four others injured, including a 3-year old child, when a light motor vehicle crashed into a tree off the N4 between Moedwil and Swaruggens, just outside Rustenburg. ER24 paramedics, along with other emergency services, arrived on scene and found a light motor vehicle crashed against a large tree. A woman and a child were found lying outside the vehicle while three men and

a woman were found inside the vehicle. Paramedics assessed the patients and found that two men, both seated in the front of the vehicle, were trapped in the wreck and showed no signs of life. Unfortunately, nothing could be done for them and they were officially declared dead on the scene. Rescue services utilized various rescue tools to free the men from the vehicle, an operation which lasted more than an hour. Once freed, paramedics treated the four patients and provided them with advanced life support interventions. Shortly after treatment, the critically injured man was airlifted by the ER24 Oneplan helicopter to a nearby hospital. The remaining three patients were transported by ambulance to a nearby hospital for urgent treatment. The cause of the accident is unknown and local authorities were at the scene for further investigations.

# Flying squad foils potential armed robbery

**Rustenburg** – The Rustenburg Flying Squad foiled a potential armed robbery after swift response following a look-out call received via social media from Rustenburg's anti-crime combating group SA Community Crime Watch (RCCW) on Wednesday, 20 September 2017.

“Information pertaining to the whereabouts of a White Mercedes Benz C180 was circulated and the Flying Squad members responded,” captain Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson, said.

Within half an hour after receiving the information, at approximately 11h00, the vehicle was spotted at the Ziniaville taxi rank, near Tlhabane. Once the driver of the vehicle became aware of the Flying Squad, he tried to flee, but the vehicle was successfully stopped and searched. The Police confiscated a revolver with its serial numbers filed off, gloves, cable ties, knives, a Police appointment certificate and some balaclavas. The 41-year old suspect who hails from Mamelodi was arrested for the illegal possession of an unlicensed firearm and ammunition. He appeared before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on 23 September. There is a strong possibility that the suspect and his accomplices may be linked to more recent cases reported in the area. The vehicle in use was rented from a local car rental company.

“We urge car rental companies or individuals to come forward and assist with the investigation”, major general Adams said. He also expressed his profound satisfaction and congratulated the officers on a job well done. “We would like to make use of this opportunity to thank Morne Engelbrecht and his RCCW team who assisted us in this case,” Augoustides said.
