Rus in Vrede veldtog sorg vir 'n skoon begraafplaas

Rustenburg – Die AfriForum tak in Rustenburg het op Saterdag 9 September die Rustenburg begraafplaas (die ou begraafplaas in Nelson Mandela Rylaan) skoongemaak. Dit is nie net spoke opjaag om te sê dat hierdie begraafplaas al vir 'n geruime tyd in 'n haglike toestand was en dat dit onveilig geword het vir inwoners om geliefdes se grafte te besoek.

Dit vorm deel van die burgerreggewagshond se nasionale Rus in Vrede-veldtog wat op die instandhouding van begraafplase fokus.

“Die plaaslike munisipaliteit versuim hul plig om die dorp se begraafplaas in stand te hou. AfriForum sal egter voortdurend druk op die munisipaliteit toepas om hul verantwoordelikheid na te kom. Tot dan is selfdoen inisiatiewe soos hierdie die beste resep,” sê Chris Trytsman, voorsitter van AfriForum se Rustenburg-tak.

Tydens hierdie skoonmaak is bome opgesny en weggery, grafte skoongemaak, grafstene wat gebreek is probeer herstel van vullis wat opgehoop het ontslae geraak.

“In die langtermyn wil ons graag al die grafte skoon en regmaak, want daar is so baie

geskiedenis en geskiedkundige monumente. Ons wil ook graag die plek beveilig sodat mense dit kan kom besoek en ons wil die gebou regmaak deur 'n dak en hek op te sit. Dit moet 'n plek wees wat mens enige tyd kan kom besoek,” sê Trytsman.

Ongeveer 30 mense het gehelp of 'n donasie gegee, insluitende mense van AfriForum Rustenburg, AfriForum Buurtweg, die stadsraad, Public Safety, JG Dromdienste, Crazy Skips, Eezy Skips, Talisman Hire Rustenburg, MBT Garage en ook lede van die publiek wat ook net daar opgedaag het.

Tiaan Oosthuizen, AfriForum se distrikskoördineerder vir Noordwes, sê dat aksies soos hierdie hoop skep en dat dit staatsonafhanklikheid binne gemeenskappe bevorder.

AfriForum het sekere projekte wat elke maand geleods word. Die Augustus projek was die “Rus in Vrede” projek waar daar besluit is om 'n begraafplaas skoon te maak. “Ons het daar gaan loop en besef dat dit die een is wat ons moet skoonmaak toe ons sien hoe die geskiedkundige grafte verniel is. Hier is so baie geskiedenis en dit is alles toegegroeï,” voeg Trytsman by.

“Ons vra vir die mense in die gemeenskap om by ons te kom aansluit. Ons benodig die ekstra hande en fondse. Ons is van die gemeenskap, vir die gemeenskap,” voeg Trytsman laastens by.
