

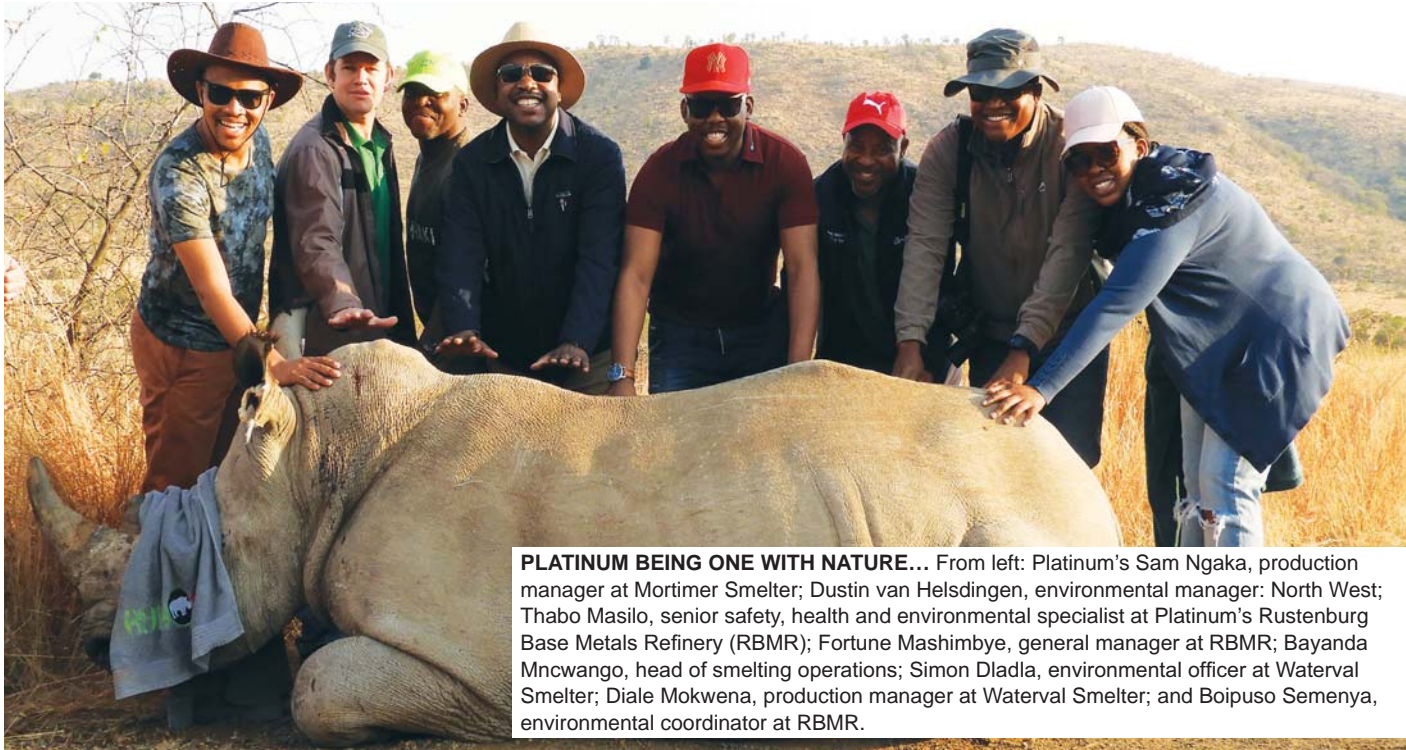
Hands off our rhino!

Rustenburg – Anglo American Platinum's Rustenburg Process Division sponsored a Rhino ear notching exercise held at Pilanesberg National Park on 16 September. This gave them a hands-on, once in a lifetime experience by actively participating to assist with the notching. Rhino populations worldwide are under severe pressure from poaching due to the demand for their horn.

Says Steve Dell, Pilanesberg field ecologist and rhino protection unit commander: "The large ears of rhino make it the perfect place to mark them. By cutting a small V, or a square shape into the ear at a certain position, uniquely identifies the rhino which is then linked to an individual number."

"The rhino conservation work conducted by the Pilanesberg Wildlife Trust in the Pilanesberg is essential to the ongoing presence of rhino populations. Without the support of companies like Anglo American Platinum, we would not manage to do this work. We thank Platinum's Rustenburg Process division for making this particular notching possible," said Dell.

Says Bayanda Mncwango, head of smelting operations and main sponsor of the event: "It is a privilege to contribute towards the protection of rhino."
