RUSTENBURG DAGGA BUST

Rustenburg/ Phokeng – The Police arrested a suspect after he was found in possession of bags loaded to the brim, filled with dagga. The dagga is valued at approximately R13 000.00 (street value).

"On Monday, 16 October, the Crime Intelligence unit and the Cluster Crime Combating Unit members made the arrest in Freedom Park, Phokeng," says captain Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson.

The suspect, Zandile Kholiso (41) has already appeared before the court and is detained while the investigation continues.

Seven bags of dagga valued at approximately R13 000.00 (street value), was busted in Rustenburg.



Explosive devices stolen from local mine

Rustenburg/ Phokeng – Two suspects, 27 and 30, were arrested on Tuesday, 17 October in Freedom Park near Phokeng for the possession of explosive devices.

Members of Rustenburg Explosives Unit and Rustenburg Dog Unit received information on a location in the Freedom Park squatter camp, where explosives were allegedly kept. "On arrival at the address, the Police found explosive devices lying around on the floor and the two suspects were arrested on the spot," says sergeant Gabaaphiwe Kgatlha, police spokesperson. "Investigations reveal that the explosives were stolen from a well-known local mine," Kgatlha added.

The recovered explosives include: 10 x 3.6m shock tubes; 15 x 4.2m shock tubes; 1x safe starter and 14 x 16 explo-gel blasting cartridges.

The suspects appeared before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 19 October. Investigations continue.
