**Potchefstroom** – The North-West University's (NWU) solar car, Naledi, crossed the finish line of the Bridgestone World Solar Challenge on Friday, 13 October, in what was a remarkable journey for an exceptional team. Naledi is the only solar car from Africa to compete in the prestigious race from Darwin to Adelaide.

Naledi, boasting both a unique design as well as advanced innovations, once again proved why nothing complements ingenuity more than dedication. The team from the NWU's Faculty of Engineering completed an astonishing 1 600km despite overcast conditions and uncommon rainstorms. The race tested the team's mettle, but despite the many obstacles faced, they prevailed in grand fashion. "The team is very happy to finally be in Adelaide and they are immensely proud of what they were able to achieve in the Bridgestone World Solar Challenge. They are great representatives of South Africa and the North-West University and everybody is very excited to see the car that we brought to Adelaide. Everything worked well on the road and now we are looking forward to coming home," Prof Albert Helberg, team captain said.

The North-West University (NWU) has been competing in solar car challenges since 2012. The NWU solar car project stands out as a symbol of engineering excellence in the pursuit of energy efficient transport technology.
