## Rustenburg's Bezuidenhout wins on the green

**Rustenburg [golf]** – Theunis Bezuidenhout rallied to a maiden IGT Challenge Tour title in the second Race to Q-School on Wednesday, 18 October. This 22-year old Rustenburg amateur outpaced five-time champion Estiaan Conradie with a final round six-under-par 66 to close out a two shot victory on 16 under 200 at Pecanwood Golf and Country Club.

Bezuidenhout claim close to a first win on the country's premier golf development circuit in the Pecanwood Challenge in May and was delighted to go the distance. "It feels great to put my hands on a trophy after knocking so many times this season," he said. "I've definitely gained experience over the last four months, because Estiaan turned up the pressure on the back nine, but I handled it really well. It was such a fantastic feeling to hole that winning putt."

Bezuidenhout posted rounds of 68 and 66 to start the last day with a two shot lead over Pieter Moolman from the Lake Club Benoni and Pretoria duo Conradie and Paul Boshoff. He birdied three, five and seven and had a lone bogey at six.

"I had a solid front nine," said Bezuidenhout. "I hit a great shot into the third to a very tight pin and holed an eight-footer for birdie to get the round going. I solid two-putt birdie at five, but I missed the green at six and couldn't up-and-down to save par. At seven I holed a 10-footer for birdie and I felt really comfortable at the turn. The other guys fell away, but Estiaan had two birdies to keep in touch. The back nine was kind to me. I played it four-under without bogeys and that gave me some confidence."

Conradie closed with a 67 to finish three shots back and a 70 from Moolman earned him third on 206.

## NWU cricket team, 'best in the world'



### Potchefstroom – 'Best in the world'...

It is a moniker bestowed on a select few, a testament to the absolute dedication to one's art. Whether as a prefix or a suffix, from 16 September to the start of the Varsity Cricket tournament in early 2018, it is the moniker that will either precede or succeed the name of the North-West University's (NWU) cricket team. This after Conrad de Swardt's team added to their Varsity Cricket crown by winning the Red Bull Campus Cricket World Final in Colombo, Sri Lanka. The tournament featured players from South Africa, Australia, Pakistan, India, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, the United Arab Emirates and Zimbabwe. The NWU, officially representing South Africa, made easy enough work of their island nation hosts in the final by chasing down their total of 121 all out in just 15.2 overs. The NWU started their campaign with a nail-biting 6-wicket win over Australia before beating India (72 runs), Pakistan (76 runs) and Bangladesh (7 wickets).

Janneman Malan walked out of the tournament as the top run scorer with

259 runs as well as the competition's most valuable player. The next best was another NWU star, Wihan Lubbe, with 152 runs and the accolade as the third most valuable player. The NWU's Dyllin Matthews was the leading wicket taker with 12 scalps. According to NWU coach Conrad de Swardt it was an experience to savour: "It sounds almost a bit weird to be called the best university cricket team in the world. It took a lot of hard work getting here, it was a three to four year process to mould this team into the shape that it is now. I think the greatest thing is seeing how boys grew into young, responsible men who now will be playing cricket in the T20 Global League."

De Swardt is, however, adamant that the club's success should not be credited to his input alone. "This club would not have been able to achieve the success it has without the dedication of Niel Bredenkamp, Pieter Knoetze and Walter Fokkens. They have an unbelievable work ethic and an unwavering commitment to the club. All credit to them as well.
