ORBIT TVET College is committed to increasing the degree of compliance with Supply Chain Management prescripts and ensuring that persons conducting or intending to conduct business with the College are afforded no scope to abuse the Supply Chain Management system.

It is therefore essential to ensure that persons conducting business with the College are tax compliant at the awarding of price quotations or competitive bids as no price quotations or competitive bids may be awarded to persons who are not tax compliant.

The South African Revenue Service introduced an enhanced tax compliance status system on eFiling aimed at improving tax compliance and making it easier for tax payers to manage their tax affairs.

The South African Revenue Service no longer issues tax clearance certificates.

As from the 1st of January 2018, the College will request a supplier to provide tax compliance status Pin for the College to utilize in order to verify the supplier/bidder's tax compliance status. The tax compliance status screen shot or letter with the result of the bidder/supplier's status at the date and time of verification will be printed and filed with the bidder/supplier's documents for audit purposes.
