Mother and baby killed on N4

Rustenburg – A woman and a baby were killed on Thursday evening, 30 November, and a man was injured when a light motor vehicle crashed into a concrete pillar on the N4 highway before the Mooienoort turnoff outside Rustenburg. ER24 paramedics arrived on the scene at approximately 22h40 and found that a light motor vehicle had split into two pieces and was found on the side of the road. The bodies of a woman, believed to be in her 30s, and a baby girl, believed to be a year old, was found lying approximately 30 metres away from the light motor vehicle. A third patient, a man, was found

walking around on the scene. Paramedics assessed the patients and found that the woman and child had sustained numerous, fatal injuries. Unfortunately, nothing could be done for them and they were both officially declared dead on the scene. The man was assessed and found to have sustained only minor injuries. The man was treated for his injuries and was transported to the Brits provincial hospital for further treatment. Investigations continue. We extend our sincerest condolences to the family and friends of the woman and her baby.



Three injured in N4 collision

Kroondal – At least three people were injured after three vehicles collided on the N4 close to Kroondal, outside Rustenburg, on Friday, 1 December. At approximately 13h30, ER24 paramedics arrived at the scene and found two women, who sustained moderate injuries, trapped in a Polo. They were treated for their wounds and transported to nearby hospitals for further medical care. One man sustained minor injuries in the collision and was treated by other emergency services on scene. Investigations continue.

School staff held at gunpoint and robbed

Rustenburg – On the morning of Tuesday, 5 December, at around 08h45, staff members and cleaners of a local secondary school were held at gun point and robbed of their valuables. A suspect, posing as a parent entered the school and requested admission forms for the new school year. On receiving the forms, the suspect made as if to leave when two more suspects armed with 9mm pistols entered the building. The three suspects then held the staff at

gunpoint and demanded all cash, cell phones and other valuables to be handed over to them. Two staff members were injured during the robbery and have received medical attention. The suspects fled the scene driving a silver/grey BMW.

"We appeal to the public to be on the lookout for these suspects and urge the community to come forward with any information regarding this crime," says sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson.

Business robbery foiled

Rustenburg/ Zinniaville – In the early hours of Saturday morning, 2 December, Bubbles Plastics in Zinniaville Industrial area was subjected to a robbery. Six suspects gained entry to the premises, placing explosives on the safe in an attempt to get to the contents it held. The suspects managed to blow up the safe, causing damage to the property. The suspects' attempt was foiled due to

the quick response of an armed response company. A number of shots were fired at the members of the armed response company. The suspects managed to flee the scene on foot.

"No injuries were reported. The suspects fled the scene empty handed. Investigation in this matter is underway," says sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson.

Rapist gets 32 years

Rustenburg/ Mogwase – A serial rapist, who had spread fear in and around the Lerone Village near Mogwase since March 2015, has received a just sentence. The accused received a 32-year sentence in the Mogwase Regional Court on Wednesday, 22 November. "Thandolwethu Dozi (28) was held for two cases of rape and one of attempted rape," says captain Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson. Through forensic

analysis the accused was linked to other criminal cases including housebreaking in Upington and rape in Carletonville.

In handing down sentence the presiding magistrate called the accused heartless and cruel.

"We congratulate sergeant Vincent Mzinyathi on an impeccable investigation which led to the arrest of the accused. We are pleased with the sentence handed down. Justice has been served," general Arthur Adams said.
