281 suspects nabbed during raids

Rustenburg – A staggering number of 281 suspects were arrested, through provincial raiding operations conducted between Thursday, 14 and Friday, 15 November. According to lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani, the suspects were arrested at all seven policing clusters in the province of which 66 arrests were carried out in Rustenburg. The Klerksdorp cluster arrested 42 suspects and 56 were arrested by the Brits cluster. The police arrested 123 suspects for assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm (GBH) and common assault, 12 for common robbery, 10 for rape, 20 for malicious damage to property,

24 for burglary at residential or business premises, 11 for contravention of protection order, and 20 for theft, three for murder and six for attempted murder. Out of the 281 arrests, 53 were for crimes against women and children. Most of the suspects already appeared in various courts throughout the province on Monday 19 November. The North West provincial commissioner, lieutenant general Baile Motswenyane commended detectives for the arrests and said: "This will definitely send a clear message to perpetrators; that they have no place to hide and that the long arm of the law will ensure that they are brought to book."

SAPS, good work reap rewards

Rustenburg – The North West SAPS annual service excellence awards ceremony was held at the Rustenburg Civic Centre on Friday 16 November. During this glamorous ceremony to salute and acknowledge South African Police Service (SAPS) members in Bokone Bophirima, brigadier Clifford Kgorane was awarded the overall winner of the evening. Brigadier Kgorane, who is overseeing the family violence, sexual offences and child protection unit (FCS) as well as the stock theft unit at the provincial office, scooped the category award for senior operational manager of the year. He was also announced as the overall winner. Apart from being a commander, he was regularly tasked to attend to serious cases that needed his know-how and guidance. Through his skills, guidance and

dedication, four rhino poachers were sentenced to a combined 90 years imprisonment. He led several high-profile cases. Brigadier Kgorane is a mentor, an example of hard work and dedication, and someone that you can look up to. The provincial commissioner encouraged a culture of positive behaviour and innovation in service delivery. "I would like to encourage all members to heed to the *Thuma Mina* call by the president and ensure a safe and secure environment for all. However, the police cannot do this without the help and cooperation of the community," said lieutenant general Baile Motswenyane during her address. The premier of North West professor Job Mokgoro, who also attended the event, congratulated the members on their achievements and acknowledged them for their services.
