

APPLICATION FOR POSTPONEMENT OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT: AIR QUALITY ACT NO. 39 OF 2004 - MINIMUM EMISSIONS STANDARDS, FOR THE IMPALA PLATINUM LIMITED SMELTER LOCATED NEAR RUSTENBURG, NORTH WEST PROVINCE, FEBRUARY 2019.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS: INVITATION TO REGISTER AND COMMENT

Impala Platinum Limited (Impala) operates a mining and processing operation approximately 16km from Rustenburg in the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality in the North West Province. Impala holds an Atmospheric Emissions Licence (AEL) and is required to comply with the Minimum Emission Standards (MES) published in terms of Section 21 of the National Environment Management: Air Quality Act, No. 39 of 2004 (NEM:AQA).

Impala is working toward compliance with the “New Plant” MES, effective on 1 April 2020, and is in the process of investigating and evaluating various improvement options to mitigate Particulate Matter (PM) emissions associated with the drying operations and Sulphur Dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) emissions associated with the tailgas scrubbing operations. Upgrades to the installed abatement equipment associated with the drying operations, as well as additional pre and post treatment circuit options form part of this investigation. The start/stop operation of the Sulphuric acid plant impacts the efficiency of the tailgas scrubbing operation, which is a tertiary abatement circuit. To mitigate the SO<sub>2</sub> emissions from the tailgas scrubbing operation, a project was launched to improve the energy balance within the Sulphuric Acid Plant. The viable option for the drying operations is expected to be implemented in a phased approach and be completed and operational by December 2024 whilst the option for addressing the SO<sub>2</sub> emissions is currently in the design phase and is expected to be operational by December 2020.

Impala wishes to apply for postponement, until December 2024, of the New Plant MES (Postponement Application), whilst it considers the outcome of the investigation for the drying operations and completes the project that is already underway to mitigate the SO<sub>2</sub> emissions.

Airshed Planning Professionals (Pty) Ltd (Airshed), an independent consulting firm of air quality specialists, has been appointed by Impala to compile the Atmospheric Impact Report (AIR) in support of the MES Postponement Application.

SLR Consulting (Africa) (Pty) Ltd (SLR), an independent environmental consulting firm, has been appointed by Impala to undertake the public participation process in support of the 2020 Postponement Application. The public participation process is being undertaken in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998): Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (GNR 982, 4 December 2014), as amended.
