## TIMELY BOOST FOR MALL CONSTRUCTION

**Rustenburg** – A resolution by the Council of the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) to allocate an additional 12 hectares of land towards the ongoing construction of a flagship shopping mall is expected to strengthen efforts to improve the lives of people living in and around the city.

The Rustenburg Mall, which will cost R1.2 billion to complete, is anticipated to create over 2,500 jobs.

Once up and running, the retail facility will assist efforts to diversify Rustenburg's economy by strengthening this sector and ensuring that communities do not rely as much on mining activities for employment opportunities.

With Sibanye-Stillwater Mine having announced

intentions to lay off more than 5,000 workers in a restructuring exercise of its Marikana operations, the construction of the mall could not have come at a better time.

It shows goodwill, on the part of the city's leaders and private investors, to grow the economy and change the face of Rustenburg by creating jobs to sustain livelihoods.

The retail facility, which will be located next to Olympia Park Stadium, will result in household budget savings for people living in Geelhoutpark, Tlhabane West and surrounding areas.

RLM spokesperson David Magae said the additional allocation of land will ensure that the project would extend beyond the retail sector.



Representatives from the RLM, JB Holdings, Moolman Group and Twin City Development were well represented during the launch of the construction phase of the mall in August.
