Rustenburg – A commitment to fight crime and bring offenders to book was made during a community policing forum (CPF) meeting held in Geelhoutpark on Wednesday 4 September. During the meeting, a new CPF committee for Rustenburg sector 2 was elected to lead the various crime fighting initiatives in the area. Tienie Bosman, who has been with the CPF in sector 2 for the past five years, said statistics show that some criminal activities are decreasing. "South Africa has a high crime rate. We especially have a high rate of murder, rape and violence against children," he said. "However, through the activities of the CPF, crime has decreased in some areas. The statistics show that in our area, housebreaking incidents for August 2019 were less than those recorded during the same month last year." Residents from the various areas that make up sector 2 pledged to work hand in glove with the newly elected committee, the police and the Department of Public Safety to intensify the fight against crime.
