NOTICE OF A BASIC ASSESSMENT AND WATER USE LICENSE AUTHORISATION PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED UPGRADE AND EXPANSION OF TURFGROND SUBSTATION, RUSTENBURG LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, NORTH WEST PROVINCE INVITATION TO REGISTER AND COMMENT

Proposed Activity: Notice is hereby given in terms of Chapter 5 of the National Environmental
Management Act (NEMA), 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) as amended and Section 41(4) of the National
Water Act No. 36 of 1998, that Transnet is proposing to upgrade the existing Turfgrond sub-station,
an 88/25kV substation located within the boundaries of Rustenburg Local Municipality. Transnet has
therefore appointed Batatise Consulting Engineers as independent Environmental Consultants, to
undertake the Basic Assessment process and submit a Water Use License for the proposed project.

Applicant: Transnet SOC Ltd

Location: The proposed project site is in the Rooiheuvel area, along the railway line between Brits
and Rustenburg. The site is bordered by mining developments and open spaces and occupies an
area of approximately 2140m² and the combined access roads constitute approximately 1703m². The
substation is located on portion 14 of the farm Middekraal 466. Direct access to the site can be gained
from the gravel road that connects to a main route east of the site. The site center co-ordinates are
25°41'21.86"S; 27° 31' 48.31"E.

Legislation: According to the NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2014, as
amended, a Basic Assessment is required as per Activity 12 and 19 of Listing Notice 1 (Government
Notice 983 of December 2014, as amended and Activity 12 of Listing Notice 3 (Government Notice
985 of December 2014, as amended). A Water Use License or General Authorisation is required in
terms of Section 21 (c) and (i) water use.

made available for public review. The draft report can be reviewed by any member of the public at the
