Rustenburg – Edward Mothibi, winner of the men's 2019 Comrades Marathon, has added another accolade to his cabinet. Edward works as a clerk at Impala Mine in Rustenburg.

The talented athlete scooped the coveted Sport Star of the Year award at the North West Sport Awards, held at Rio Casino in Klerksdorp on Friday 18 October. The glitzy event, hosted by the provincial Department of Arts, Culture, Sport and Recreation, saw Edward ending the year on a high following his impressive performance in the Comrades.

Netball star Monique Reyneke, a student at North West University and member of the Proteas team, was also recognised for her efforts after being named runner up.

Competing against a quality line-up of other marathon runners from many countries, Edward finished the prestigious race in a time of 5:31:33. He secured his name in the history books of the Comrades Marathon after crossing the line before 2018 winner Bongumusa Mthembu.

Other winners of the provincial awards include Gaofenngwe Tlatsana, Kgomoitso Itlhabayeng, Sylvia Mokaila, Kagiso Mooketsi, Tshwanelo Moabi and Helena Botha.
