

TOP FIGHTER CONTINUES TO SHINE

Rustenburg – Sensei Pieter Venter continues to make a name for himself as one of the top martial arts fighters and instructors in the country. He is also making an impression on the world stage. During the Traditional Styles Known Knowledge in Action Federation (TSKKIA) competition held in Rustenburg from Friday 11 to Sunday 13 October, he managed to retain his title as the top fighter in South Africa. Competing against some of the best competitors in the world, he achieved TSKKIA national status by winning five gold medals in the five events he competed in. Sensei Pieter Venter is officially recognised by the International Association of Instructors, the Australian Shotokan Karate federation, KFCI and ISSKA. He is a 3rd dan black belt fighter in Tokon Shotokan Karate and is also a black belt Instructor in Gendaiteki Ken & Iai Jitsu (Japanese Sword Art) and Gendaiteki Kyujitsu (Japanese Archery). "He is one of the top instructors at the Rustenburg Tokon Karate Honbu Dojo," said kancho Albert, founder of TSKKIA and renowned martial arts expert.
