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PONGVILLE the community says



The stench coming from the RCL FOODS plant has been a thorn in the side for the Zinniaville community over the past few years.

Rustenburg/Zinniaville – Zinniaville, also referred to as Pongville, faces a never-ending stinky situation.

"Our quality of life is diminishing. The smell is affecting our lives and our dignity," Zinniaville resident Muhammed Minty said.

The operation

RCL Foods operates the Epol feedmill, the Rainbow chicken processing plant, and the Waste to Value plant in Zinniaville. Matzonox provides waste management services for RCL Foods. A biodigester was built at the RCL Foods plant as part of their Waste to Value initiative. The plant was commissioned in early 2020 to process animal manure from the company's farms as well as partially treated effluent (waste) pumped from the RCL abattoir and the poultry by-products plant.

Grievances voiced at previous stakeholder meetings

In Platinum Weekly's issue of 2 April 2021, it was reported that residents in the Zinniaville area were complaining about a foul smell in the air in Zinniaville and its industrial area.

Since then, there have been several stakeholder meetings between Zinniaville Rate Payer's Association, RCL Foods and the Bojanala District Municipality to discuss the recurring foul air experienced in the area as well as RCL Foods' Waste to Value Plant.

The pending air pollution licence was also discussed during these meetings.

During the meetings in April and June 2021, the chairperson of the Zinniaville Ratepayers Association Soyab Bham and Rubinah Soomar requested that the conditions of the authorisation for RCL to operate be made available to them. This would include the Environmental Impact Assessment and Environmental Management report, operating licences, and monitoring records.

Public participation meeting on Monday 12 September

RCL is currently in the process of applying for an Atmospheric Emissions Licence (AEL).

In order to apply for the AELs it requires Matzonox to host public participation meetings with affected communities. The notices were also placed at various points in the communities and apparently also in two newspapers, one of which is based in Mahikeng.

Although there are several residential suburbs of Rustenburg within 5km of the plant, the closest include Karlien Park and Zinniaville directly to the south, Seraleng to the north-northeast, and Boitekong to the east.

During the meeting at the Zinniaville Secondary School Hostel on Monday 12 September 2022, the community voiced their concerns about the lingering foul smell.

The community has until 7 October to submit their complaints or comments for consideration.

The meeting was led by The Environmental Practice's Colleen McCreadie who started with a presentation, which was later interrupted by community members who made it clear that they are tired of the smell and will not condone the plant getting an AEL.

Another community member said: "Living with the smell is not living, it is punishment." A medical practitioner from the Zinniaville community spoke up about being concerned about the health of the people living in the community, regardless of the studies showing that the plant is not a health risk. Many community members noted that they have been living with the foul smell for more than 30 years and that it has become unbearable over the last few years. They invited the representatives from RCL FOODS, Matzonox and The Environmental Practice to bring their families to come and stay in the community for some time to experience the stench first-hand. "The plant was constructed to reduce RCL FOODS' water, waste, and carbon footprint, so it is sad that the communities feel that it has this negative impact on their lives," said RCL FOODS group sustainability executive Ettienne Thiebaut.

RCL FOODS corporate communications manager Virginia Horsley said: "RCL FOODS has been involved in the Rustenburg community for decades as a major employer. Its wellbeing is important to us, and we are committed to a good working relationship with our community members. This is part of our journey to ensure a sustainable business into the future, which also includes improving our operations' environmental sustainability."

All the information, community comments and reports have will have to be accessed by the Bojanala Local Municipality air quality officer (AQO), and the assistance of the national AQO can also be called in to make the final decision on if the licence will be issued.



Unlawful entry on Premises Bill, 2022

???

Invitation for Public Comments



Take note:

- The proposed law is not applicable to government property (critical infrastructure or national key points or any public place), but it is applicable to your home, your business, and your farm.
- Of all the many unlawful acts that can be committed, this proposed law makes it the duty of law-abiding citizens (the victims) to put up signage to discourage perpetrator/s to not act unlawfully (trespass). Imagine having to put up signs for every unlawful act under the sun, to try and keep perpetrators from acting unlawful.
- This law also specifies in detail the exact steps you must follow, should a perpetrator enter your home, your business, or your farm unlawfully. Is there exact prescribes of what a law-abiding citizen should do – when encountering one of the myriad other unlawful acts of perpetrators?
- When you are a victim of a trespasser, you cannot just call on any police officer if an incident occurs. You have to make contact with an 'authorised member' – means a suitably qualified and experienced member of the South African Police Service, authorised thereto by the National Commissioner of the South African Police Service to perform, in addition to their normal functions and duties, such functions as are conferred or imposed upon them by this Act.'

If this bill is passed, and enforced... What is the consequences if you (the citizen) do not follow the rules to the T, should a trespasser enter your home?

SA – On 12 August 2022 the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development issued a notice in the Government Gazette, inviting public comments on the proposed *Unlawful Entry on Premises Bill, 2022* (the Bill).

The main purpose of the Bill is:

- To repeal and replace the *Trespass Act, No. 6 of 1959*, and
- To prohibit unlawful entry on premises.

Justice minister Ronald Lamola says the *Trespass Act, No. 6 of 1959* has lost its relevance in the South African constitutional democracy. His department seeks to repeal the law and replace it with the proposed *Unlawful Entry on Premises Bill, 2022* (the Bill).

The proposed Bill is a document consisting of seven pages, which is available on the following website:

The following amendments were made to the Act:

- Sections 1 to 3 amended by Extension of Security of Tenure Act 62 of 1997
- Section 2 amended by Criminal Law Amendment Act 59 of 1983

The proposed 7-page bill to replace the 2-page bill which has lost its relevance describes in detail what a person should do when a trespasser enters his property, be it the building called home, a farm, or a business premises. Several terms were also changed for example:

...unless he has lawful reason to enter... was replaced by ...the person charged reasonably believed that they had title to or an interest in the premises... and ...there is a presumption that access for lawful purposes...

Parliament is the national legislature (law-making body) of South Africa. As such, one of its major functions is to pass new laws, to amend existing laws, and to repeal old laws. Both houses of Parliament – the National Assembly and the National Council of Provinces (NCOP) – play a role in this process. Once it is signed by the President, it becomes an Act of Parliament and a law of the land.

Has this process not become just as irrelevant as the act it now wishes to replace? Should the process not be widened in the design stages of the proposed act. So that the man on the street can understand the formation of the law and so that more role-players and legal experts in the field have the opportunity to contribute... rather than give a law to be commented on which is riddled with loopholes and open for personal interpretation.

You can read through the proposed bill and give your inputs to the director general, or you can sit on the shoreline and watch the ship pass by. It is up to you. You must ask yourself: 'Is this law doable, or would it just work on paper?'

What are the practical implications to the detail that is given in this proposed law of how a situation with an intruder should be handled?

Let's say you opened your gate with the remote, and at the time your daughter opened the front door of the house, an intruder made use of the opportunity to gain access to your property and your house. So, following the new proposed act... the intruder might presume he/she had access because the access was not prohibited (open gate... open door).

Would the natural behaviour of the intruder/s be to listen as you speak to the intruder/s, informing them that they are not welcome and should leave? Would it be natural for you to then turn your back on the intruder, while they patiently wait for you to speak to the police, which might take a long time, as it is sometimes difficult to get through to the police.

Taking into account that the police struggle with limited resources, and that they might only be able to contact you back the following day, because they did not have available vehicle or personnel...

Would the SAPS officer be responsible for deciding if there is any legal 'presumption' before removing the intruder from your house?

What if the family of your ex-husband decides to rock up on your farm and removes the signage which you have placed on the gate. You phone SAPS, but because they cannot respond immediately, the family of your ex-husband, offloads their mobile home and start planting some veggies... What would SAPS do if they get to your place? Would SAPS remove them or would SAPS wait for a court order?

Fire damages liquor shop

Rustenburg – The thatched roof of a liquor shop along the R24 outside Rustenburg was extensively damaged by a fire on Saturday 10 September.

The cause of the fire, which engulfed the roof of Blue Bottle Liquors at around 17:00, is the subject of an investigation by personnel from the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM).

Said RLM head of communication Thapelo Matebesi: "Rustenburg Emergency and Disaster Management attended to the fire at the Orange Grove Complex along the R24. Half of the thatched roof of the shop was badly damaged in the fire. A multi-purpose fire engine, manned by four crew members, was deployed at 17:10 and the fire was extinguished."

No injuries were reported.

35 learners inside 16-seater

Moruleng – A 22-year-old driver found himself in hot water for loading 35 learners (aged 14 to 16) in a minibus permitted to carry only 16 passengers. On Friday 9 September, the driver was fined by North West provincial traffic police officers for overloading.

Traffic police officers, who stopped the vehicle along the D550 road in Moruleng, also discovered that the driver did not have the authorisation to transport learners. He was fined R5,000 for the offences. Said acting chief director for transport regulations Paul Stone: "The driver was transporting learners without a scholar operating license and was not contracted by the department. He was therefore charged for non-compliance with the National Land Transport Act. Overloading is a serious offense."

Lapa engulfed

The fire burnt down the lapa in Tortelduif Avenue.



The burning lapa was visible to motorists travelling along the N4.

Rustenburg – Nobody was injured during a fire which gutted a lapa in Tortelduif Avenue in Cashan. The cause of the incident, which occurred on Saturday 10 September, is not yet clear at this stage.

Some motorists travelling along the N4 spotted the raging flames and alerted the fire brigade. Jonathan du Toit, a community member, was one of the people who arrived at the scene to assist in the emergency. "The incident occurred somewhere between 11:00 and 12:00. We came in to help. Luckily nobody was hurt," du Toit said. "Firefighters from the Rustenburg municipality also arrived to extinguish the blaze," he added.

Platinum thieves jailed

Tlhabane/ Rustenburg – Two men were found guilty of unlawful possession of precious metals by the Tlhabane Magistrates' Court on Friday 9 September 2022.

They were also sentenced as illegal immigrants.

Samuel Bandi (30) and Hardlife Makoto (28) were each sentenced to seven years direct imprisonment as well as one year for contravention of the Immigration Act. Two years of the sentence were suspended for five years.

Hawks spokesperson for the North West captain Tlanelani Rikhotso said the two will therefore effectively remain behind bars for the next five years. Rikhotso revealed the pair was arrested by security personnel outside a Rustenburg mine on 25 November 2021 after they were found in possession of platinum.

"They were found in possession of platinum they had stolen from the mine pipeline. The members of the Hawks' Serious Organised Crime Investigation were roped in to investigate the matter," Rikhotso said. Bandi and Makoto made their first court appearance on 29 November 2021.

"They were remanded in custody owing to their illegal status in the country. They then made a series of court appearances until they were sentenced," Rikhotso added.

Criminals are taking over in Derby

Derby – "Dis leeu wêreld in Derby"… words uttered by Derby neighbourhood watch member Peet Els after they spent a restless weekend fighting crime. Neighbourhood watch members were patrolling the streets keeping a lookout for criminals who rely on the dark of night, aided by loadshedding, to carry out their wheelings and dealings. There also seems to be an influx of people coming from other areas to wreak havoc in what is supposed to be a quiet, small town.

- In one instance, on Sunday 11 September in the early hours of the morning, there was a group of unknown men loitering at the local garage. The neighbourhood watch members went to investigate. The men first tried to hide but were eventually chased to the Ventersdorp road where they were picked up by an unknown female just before 1am.
- The members continued their patrol and heeded the call of a person who alerted that someone was trying to forcefully access their premises.
- After spending hours patrolling, the members headed home to get a bit of sleep. Els had just arrived home and was ready to go to bed when he heard someone crying for help. It was a man that had been stabbed in the face. According to the injured man, there were two other females that were also stabbed by the same man. He was taken to hospital to be treated for his injuries. Els advised him to open a case at the police station but was informed that the police can't assist, as they need to speak to the victim first.

This is just a few of the cases the neighbourhood watch had to deal with in one evening – and this happens night after night.

"We don't get any sleep as we are either patrolling or reacting to crime reports. The fact that there is no police station in Derby, and we aren't really getting assistance from the Koster Police, does not make our job easier. If we don't do it, who will look out for the community?" Els asked.

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Environmentalist sheds light on plight of Majakaneng people

Majakaneng – When undertaking research in underdeveloped communities, it is difficult to stay firmly in the project's stated aims and objectives. Fortunately, participatory action research is an unusual research method as it requires the researcher to remain open to changing the goal posts as the community directs the outcome.

Cathy Dzerefos from Tshwane University of Technology agreed to meet with the executive of Word of Motive (WoM) in Majakaneng on Saturday 3 September. WoM was formed in 2020 in response to the Covid-19 lockdown which prevented people from attending church. Members were added to WhatsApp groups and in this way could pray and read scriptures together. It is estimated that about 15 African Apostolic churches form part of WoM.

The Saturday meeting was arranged to discuss signage that had been designed to encourage the sustainable use of natural areas used for baptisms, collection of holy water and other traditional rituals. These sacred spaces in the Magaliesberg and further afield are at risk of becoming contaminated and degraded unless environmental stewardship principles are adopted.

After the signage were discussed, WoM shared that there were vulnerable people in the community that weighed on their hearts and that they were trying to assist. The researcher explained that she could help document the stories of the destitute which could then be used to source funding.

WoM requested assistance for two sisters living close to the Majakaneng kloof in the burnt ruins of their grandmother's house. The older sister (23) is the mother of twin boys aged three. The younger sister (17) is in Grade 11 and dreams of studying to be a social worker. They survive on the children's social grant and food from the neighbours, but when WoM visited them, they had not eaten for two days.

They are using the original corrugated iron roof that was burnt in the fire as their shelter and have no furniture. The door is kept closed with a 10-litre container of water. When it rains, the water runs through the shelter.

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




Cycling up a storm in Canada


two teams will compete in during the 2023 season.




