A parent's struggle?

How can you really help?

Rustenburg - On Joubert Street, a troubling scene regularly unfolds, and it has caught the attention and stirred the emotions of many a passerby. A woman, with her toddler seated in a shopping trolley, reaches out to the community for assistance. What perhaps distinguishes her is her ingenuity, as she has fashioned a makeshift roof for the trolley, providing shade for her child amid her task of asking for help.

The story of this mother and child evokes a myriad of questions and emotions in those who encounter them. Many observers empathise with her as a mother who is doing her utmost with limited resources. The questions that come to mind are: 'Where do they sleep? Where do they wash themselves? Are they safe? Are they in danger of sexual predators on the streets? The image of her pushing the trolley, while seeking help, prompts thoughts of her inner strength, resilience, and determination, particularly in the face of possible public scrutiny and judgment.

Nevertheless, beneath the surface, there is an acknowledgment that this situation may be far more complex than meets the eye. One overarching query remains: how can the community respond effectively to such situations? Is there a sustainable solution that could potentially alleviate the predicament faced by such individuals?

Platinum Weekly reached out to Rustenburg Child & Family Welfare manager, Deidre Janse van Vuuren, and received the following advice: "When a parent uses a child for the purpose of generating money or asking for any goods, even food, it is considered exploitation and should be reported to a child protection organisation, such as Rustenburg Child and Family Welfare. A social worker will conduct further investigations and perform an evaluation to determine if such a child is in need of care and protection. The informant can only provide information about where the person usually is located and descriptive information about their appearance".

Africa's largest vulture relocation project gets the green light

Hartebeespoort / Eastern Cape - The largest relocation of vultures ever undertaken reached a critical milestone when approval was granted to move a first tranche of 155 birds to a new home in the Eastern Cape. Now that the Department of Forestry Fisheries and Environment has given the green light, work is underway on a bespoke facility at Shamwari Private Game Reserve adjacent to its existing Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre. VulPro at Shamwari will be the new home for the Cape and African White-backed Vultures, which will be transported from their current home at VulPro's Hartebeespoort Dam facility in late January during the first phase of the two-year relocation programme. VulPro is the only vulture conservation facility of its kind on the continent and is spearheading population restocking and supplementation to address the severe decline of African vulture species. VulPro CEO, Kerri Wolter, says that the partnership with Shamwari will create a safe area for both in-situ and ex-situ conservation programmes. "Vultures, with their important and efficient ecosystem services, are a significant addition to the ethos Shamwari has created in restoring a natural and well-balanced ecosystem. In addition, the stability and financial support that Shamwari brings provide sustainability to VulPro's breeding programme and the future of vultures in South Africa." She explains that the vultures being moved to VulPro at Shamwari are all non-releasable breeding birds. After the Cape and African white-backed vultures move in January, a second phase will see non-releasable breeding pairs of Lappet-faced, White-headed, and Hooded Vultures, and some additional White-backed Vultures being relocated. The Cape Vulture offspring will be released on Shamwari and will all be fitted with tracking devices. The remaining species' offspring will be transported back to VulPro's Hartebeespoort facility, where they will be sent to release sites that the National Vulture breeding Steering Committee has identified as areas where the species need bolstering and support. Joe Cloete, Shamwari CEO, says that in conservation terms, the project is as significant as anything that has been done on

the reserve over the past 30 years. The Shamwari conservation project began in 1992 when it started trying to reverse nearly 300 years of human impact by reintroducing elephants, white rhinos, and hippos in 1992. Black rhinos and buffalo followed in 1993/4. Cheetahs, lions, and brown hyenas were brought back in 2000, and servals and leopards the next year, making Shamwari the first big-five game reserve in the Eastern Cape. "Vultures play a vital role in maintaining a healthy ecosystem, are part of our natural heritage, and are severely threatened. I cannot overstate how reintroducing Cape Vultures is a critical step in the continuing evolution of our conservation journey and enhancing the ecological importance of the reserve," says Cloete.



FIRE CLAIMS A FAMILY OF FIVE AT A HARTBEEspoort SHELTER

Hartbeespoort - A heart-rending incident unfolded on the evening of Sunday 29 October at the Purple Moss shelter for the homeless near Hartbeespoort. A young couple, along with their three children - two girls, aged 2 and 3, and a boy aged 8, tragically lost their lives in a fire that consumed their living space. The family found themselves trapped inside the burning building, seemingly unable to find the key to their security door. Eyewitnesses from the Purple Moss shelter relayed distressing accounts of their fervent attempts to rescue the family. Regrettably, despite their efforts, the situation was overwhelming. The fire, which is believed to have ignited from a candle, reportedly started just before 21:00, aligning with the timing of load-shedding. The father's pleas for assistance alerted nearby residents, but the family's security gate was locked. The flames quickly spread to neighbouring rooms and other parts of the shelter. Both the Hartbeespoort Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) and the Madibeng Brits Fire Department responded promptly, battling to put out the fire. Despite their efforts, the family was tragically pronounced dead at the scene. Police spokesperson colonel Adele Myburgh reported: "Another resident allegedly went outside his room, when he noticed the room was engulfed in flames. Efforts to break open the room was unsuccessful. After the fire was extinguished, paramedics declared all five family members dead on the scene".



JST guarantees uninterrupted service delivery amid water scarcity challenges

Rustenburg - Job Shimankana Tabane (JST) Hospital has been approved and gazetted as a 390-bed hospital. JST has been serving as a vital referral hospital in the Bojanala District. With a population of 1.8 million, the Bojanala District faces challenges in healthcare access, and 90% of the Bojanala District residents remain uninsured. JST has recently faced intermittent water supply disruptions, which posed a potential risk to

jeopardize the hospital's ability to care for patients effectively. In response to these challenges, JST management implemented a series of measures to ensure continuous and reliable water availability in the hospital, as follows: Increased water storage capacity: Invested in new water reservoir tanks with an additional capacity of 60,000 liters. This enhancement significantly improves the

hospital's ability to store water for daily operational needs.

Upgraded water pumping system: To further bolster water supply capabilities, installed new water pumps with a total capacity of 8 kilowatts and replaced the old pump with a more powerful 22-kilowatt pump. These upgrades enhance the hospital's ability to distribute water efficiently throughout the hospital.

Collaboration with the municipality and hospital-arranged water tankers: While the hospital's primary water supply comes from Rustenburg Local Municipality, the hospital recognizes the importance of having contingency plans. In collaboration with both the municipality and the hospital-arranged water tankers, the hospital ensures that the reservoirs remain adequately filled even during supply disruptions," said the acting chief executive officer, Dr George Maesela.

Management reassures the public that, despite the water supply challenges faced by JST, the hospital remains fully operational.

"Long-term water security initiatives: JST is committed to the long-term security of water supply. The hospital's future plans include the installation of a larger reservoir and the drilling of a borehole to ensure emergency water supply capabilities. These initiatives will further fortify the ability to provide consistent care to patients," Maesela concluded.

Rustenburg Cycling Club's Luyt family joins Rhino Conservation Ride

Rustenburg - Over the past weekend, the Luyt family, who are members of the Rustenburg Cycling Club (RCC) community, took part in the Rhino Conservation Ride. In 2013, the Tour de Pilanesberg Wilderness (TdPW) was conceived as both a dream and a fundraiser for rhino protection in Pilanesberg. The ambitious goal was to organize a cycling event that would immerse participants in the heart of the wilderness, where rhinos were most vulnerable to poaching. The tragic history of rhino poaching in the Pilanesberg dates back to 2010 when the first rhino, Suzie, a beloved black rhino mother, was poached. The situation escalated until 2020 when all the rhinos in Pilanesberg had their horns removed during a massive nine-day operation. What initially began as a small initiative with only six cyclists has evolved into a spectacular event, fueled by word-of-mouth promotion over the past decade, now celebrating its 10th annual edition in 2023. The success of the TdPW owes its gratitude to the Pilanesberg Wildlife Trust (PWT), park management, dedicated cyclists, and volunteers. PWT Manager

Perry Dell initiated the TdPW cycle initiative in 2013 to fund rhino protection, coinciding with the rising popularity of cycling as an alternative to golf. Over the course of ten years, the event has reached its peak popularity, capped at 80 cyclists to ensure their safety. Extensive security measures, including aerial support with helicopters, armed ground teams preceding and following the cyclists, and guards at critical points along the route, guarantee the participants' safety. In the 2023 edition, 60 cyclists had one of the most remarkable experiences of their lives, traversing historical poaching sites and the cherished habitats of wildlife like Rain, the recently deceased cheetah that roamed Pilanesberg. Participants encountered an array of wildlife, including rhinos, elephants, buffalo, kudu, giraffes, and even springbok, celebrating the rugby World Cup win. The event has attracted participants ranging from 17 to 77 years of age, representing diverse walks of life, making it a "must-do" for many bucket lists. The success of this event is a testament to the dedication of volunteers and cyclists alike.
