## NEWBORN FOUND DUMPED IN RIVER

**Rustenburg** – A tragic discovery was made on Tuesday, 17 December 2024. The lifeless body of a newborn baby girl was found discarded in a filthy river near Reutwile, an informal settlement near the R510. The shocking find was made by a passerby around 13:00, who immediately alerted authorities. Adding to the horror of the discovery, the baby girl was wrapped in a plastic bag and submerged in the dirty water.

This is no ordinary river. It is choked with sewage, reeking of decay, and littered with heaps of rotting rubbish. The stench was overwhelming, and the water's surface was a tragic mix of filth and debris. When the police arrived, curious onlookers from the community gathered, drawn by the flashing lights and the unfolding tragedy.

The baby's body, concealed in the plastic bag, was barely recognisable. Decomposed and mingled with the trash, it was almost impossible to discern that this was once a tiny, fragile life. One onlooker remarked with anguish, "It was heartbreaking; you couldn't even tell it was a baby at first."

The discovery has sparked outrage and sorrow among residents. DA councillor Luan Snyders added, "The baby's body had begun to decompose, worsened by the extreme heat of the South African sun."

The thought of what the baby's final moments might have been is haunting. Did she breathe for even a second, only to be thrust into this horrifying world – a world that discarded her like rubbish?

Police spokesperson, colonel Adele Myburgh, confirmed the tragic incident. "It is a newborn baby girl. The identities of both the mother and the child remain unknown at this time. The cause of death will be determined through a post-mortem examination."

## DON'T DUMP YOUR BABY

THERE ARE OTHER OPTIONS

While the circumstances leading to the abandonment are unclear, child welfare organisations stress that help is available for struggling mothers. Deidre Janse van Vuuren, manager of Rustenburg Child and Family Welfare, emphasised, "Women need to know that there are alternatives available to them. Social workers provide counselling, support during pregnancy, and assistance with adoption processes without judgement." Helen Lotz, director of Môrester Children's Home, shared her heartbreak over the incident. "My heart breaks every time I hear of a dumped baby. Even if a baby is born at home and you decide not to keep it, you can still go to the hospital

and speak to a social worker," she said. Lotz also noted that in cases of stillbirth, it's crucial to contact a doctor to declare the baby's death and follow proper procedures. "If you did nothing wrong, there is nothing to fear," she reassured.

**Abandoning a baby without seeking help is a criminal offence. Mothers face charges of concealment of birth, and police use DNA testing to identify and prosecute those responsible. Using the correct channels not only gives the baby a chance at life but also ensures the mother's health and legal protection.**

## Child abandonment: a national crisis

Specialist investigator into Serious Violent, Serious Economic Crimes & Serious Cybercrimes, Mike Bolhuis highlighted the underlying issues contributing to baby abandonment in South Africa. "Teenage pregnancies are a significant factor, with nearly one in four girls falling pregnant before the age of 20. Many young mothers lack financial independence, support, or maturity to care for a child," he explained. He added: "In South Africa in 2022/23, approximately 150,000 pregnancies were recorded among girls aged 10 to 19, some involving statutory rape."

### Legal consequences of abandonment

Abandoning a baby is a serious criminal offence in South Africa. If the child dies or is harmed due to neglect, the mother can face charges of murder, culpable homicide, or violations under the Children's Act.



**ONE MORE ESCAPEE CAUGHT IN SWARTRUGGENS PRISON BREAK; ONE REMAINS AT LARGE****STILL WANTED**

**Swartruggens** – Swift action by the Swartruggens police and local community members has led to the re-arrest of another detainee following the daring escape from police holding cells on Sunday, 8 December 2024.

**Re-arrested**

Mpho Vincent Madito (29), detained on charges of multiple rape cases in Swartruggens and Makgobstad, was the first to be apprehended on 10 December 2024. He was caught during a coordinated operation by the Swartruggens Visible Policing Unit and the Phokeng Flying Squad, after boarding a bus

in Tlokweng village heading for Rustenburg CBD. Madito is now facing additional charges of escape from lawful custody and possession of suspected stolen property. He appeared in court on Thursday, 12 December 2024.

**Latest update:** On Wednesday, 11 December 2024, at approximately 18:00, police operationalised a tip-off with the assistance of a local farmer's neighbourhood watch. This joint effort resulted in the re-arrest of Johannes Mfaladi (28), who was found hiding on a farm in the Swartruggens area. Mfaladi, detained for assault with intent to cause grievous bodily harm (GBH), is also facing additional charges

of escaping lawful custody. He appeared before the Swartruggens Magistrates' Court on Friday, 13 December 2024.

**Still at large**

Only one escapee remains at large following the incident: Thapelo Mogwele Molebatsi (25), detained for theft in Swartruggens.

**The police urge anyone with information regarding Molebatsi's whereabouts to come forward.**

**COMMUNITY AND POLICE COLLABORATION FOILS ROBBERY, SIX SUSPECTS ARRESTED**

**Rustenburg** – Collaborative efforts by vigilant community members, a private security company, and the police have led to the arrest of five men and a woman for business robbery in Luka, near Phokeng.

The accused – Orphan Pokane (25), Bohlokwa Molapo (23), Pitso Makhoane (34), Peter Fuzani (42), Makabelo Maboe (38), and Johannes Hlabanelo (50) – were apprehended on Tuesday morning, 10 December 2024.

Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone detailed how the arrest followed an incident where four armed men stormed a local shop, forced the shopkeeper to lie face down, and looted cash, cellphones, and cigarettes. The suspects then locked the shopkeeper inside before fleeing in a silver-grey Ford Figo.

In a dramatic twist, the shopkeeper escaped through an unlocked back door, alerted a colleague, and, along with a quick-thinking citizen, pursued the robbers. The chase ended in a cul-de-sac, where the suspects abandoned their vehicle and attempted to flee on foot. Swift action from the Royal Bafokeng Reaction Force and local police ensured their arrest.

The accused appeared before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 12 December 2024, where they were remanded in custody. Their next court date is set for Wednesday, 15 January 2025. Police investigations are ongoing, with a possibility of linking the suspects to other criminal activities.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, provincial police commissioner, commended the cooperative efforts of all involved parties, emphasising the importance of such partnerships in ensuring community safety.

- Not texting while driving





# Step-by-step guide to complaints and grievance procedure

## Receive grievance/ complaint

- Walk-Ins: ESD Centres and CED Department offices
- Anonymous Hot-line
- Written: Letters, SMS and Email
- Third Party Referrals i.e South Africa Human Rights Commission, Local Councillors, Municipal offices, Traditional Authority, Community Leaders, Non-Governmental Organisations/ Community Based Organisations and DMRE.

STEP 1



## 48 hours grievance/ complaint registered and acknowledged

- Registration of grievance/ complaint into Issue Register/ IsoMetrix
- Acknowledgement of Receipt to the Complainant by CED Department in language and form of communication the Complainant is comfortable with.

STEP 2



## 48 hours internal review of grievance/ complaint

- Assess nature of Grievance/Complaint
- Allocation to relevant Business Unit/ Department

STEP 3



## Depending on nature of grievance/ complaints, investigation process outlined Business Unit/ Department

- CED Department to liaise with the Business Unit representative assigned to investigate the grievance/ complaint if additional information required from the Complainant
- Business Unit representative assigned to the case to provide clear time frames of when the investigation will be completed.

STEP 4



## Investigation and fact finding

- Investigation to commence led by the Business Unit representative assigned to the case
- Business Unit Representative to provide outcome of the investigation to CED, then CED to liaise with the Complainant to schedule a suitable time to give feedback on outcome of investigation.

STEP 5



## Feedback to complainant on outcome of investigation.

- Feedback provided to the Complainant in a set-up that is most suitable to them such as a meeting, written (letter or email) or telephone feedback depending nature of complaint/grievance.
- Feedback provided in a language preferred by the Complainant.

STEP 6



## Grievance/ complaint resolved

- CED Department will liaise with the Complainant(s) if satisfied with the outcome of the investigation and the response from the business.
- If the Complainant(s) is/are satisfied with outcome of investigation the CED Department to capture the issue as resolved/ closed in Issue Register/ IsoMetrix system.

STEP 7



## Grievance/ complaint not resolved

- If the Complainant(s) is/are not satisfied with the outcome of the investigation, the issue will be captured as open on the Issue Register/IsoMetrix and escalated to the management representative responsible for the Business Unit.
- The alternative step following failure to resolve the issue internally is to be referred to an Independent Mediator/ Facilitator such as the South African Human Rights Commission.

STEP 8



## Independent mediation/ facilitation

- Following the outcome of the mediation efforts, if the Complainant(s) is/are satisfied with outcome the issue will be captured as closed on the system and the recommendations implemented by Sibanye-Stillwater.

STEP 9



## Litigation

- If the Complainant(s) is/are not satisfied with the outcome with independent Mediator/Facilitator they can exercise their right to approach the Courts to litigate against Sibanye-Stillwater.

STEP 10


