Rustenburg – What started as a single online tip-off turned into a 10-hour rescue mission for the Rustenburg Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) — ending with four leopard tortoises saved from illegal trade and a deeper look into a growing underground market.

On Friday 4 July 2025, a Rustenburg SPCA inspectorate sprang into action after receiving information about a tortoise being sold on Facebook. Working into the early morning hours of 5 July, the team traced the post to a location near Sun City, where they discovered not one, but four leopard tortoises being held.

The suspected trader was not present at the scene, but the investigation is ongoing, and the rescue has already uncovered a wider network of illegal wildlife dealings in the area. The rescue mission was made possible through swift support from Sun City Police.


# 12 LIVES LOST IN NW ROAD CRASHES OVER ONE WEEKEND

**North West** – A devastating weekend on North West roads has claimed 12 lives in just 48 hours, with multiple serious collisions reported between Friday, 11 July and Sunday, 13 July 2025.

On Friday, a fatal crash on the N14 near Tshing, Ventersdorp, marked the start of a tragic sequence. Later that evening, a horrific head-on collision involving four vehicles on the N4 near Groot Marico left five people dead. According to reports, two delivery vehicles from the same company were towing each other while overtaking, when they collided with two oncoming vehicles. All five victims — four women and one man — were in the latter vehicles. The drivers of the delivery vehicles, three Zimbabwean nationals and one Malawian, survived with injuries and were hospitalised. Saturday brought another loss when a pedestrian was killed in a hit-and-run on the N12 near Potchefstroom, en route to Stilfontein. On Sunday evening, four more lives were lost on the N18, approximately 40km south of Mahikeng near Setlagole, when two vehicles collided head-on. A light sedan, reportedly overtaking, crashed into an oncoming delivery vehicle. All occupants — three men and one woman — died at the scene.

Tragedy struck again shortly thereafter, near Madiba a Makgabana village. A vehicle hit a stray cow, and another travelling behind ran over the animal. Three passengers sustained serious injuries, while a child sadly died at the scene.

MEC for Community Safety and Transport Management, Wessels Morweng, expressed heartfelt condolences to the bereaved families and wished the injured a speedy recovery. Investigations are underway, and cases of culpable homicide have been opened in connection with all incidents.



# NEARLY 900 NABBED IN OPERATION SHANELA II

**North West** – Police in the province have dealt a heavy blow to criminal activity during the latest week-long Operation Shanel II blitz, arresting a staggering 894 suspects between Monday, 7 July and Sunday, 13 July 2025.

Officers seized illegal firearms, drugs, liquor, and dangerous weapons, with suspects nabbed for a wide range of crimes including murder (15), attempted murder (11), robbery (19), assault (162) and drug-related offences (183 combined). Colonel Adéle Myburgh confirmed that 67 illegal immigrants were also detained for contravening immigration laws, pending deportation. Notably, 411 of the arrested individuals were wanted suspects, positively linked to crimes through forensic DNA evidence.

A key success story unfolded in Mahikeng, where officers executed a search warrant at a house in Lonely Park on 7 July. They discovered a firearm with filed-off serial numbers, ammunition, and suspected crystal meth. Poloko Lentswana (23) was arrested on the spot and remains in custody, facing charges of illegal possession of a firearm and drugs.

Acting provincial police commissioner major general Patrick Asaneng praised the unrelenting efforts of officers involved, saying the operation reinforces a zero-tolerance stance on violent crime, substance abuse, and social decay.

## SPCA opens cruelty case after viral chicken video

**Rustenburg** – A shocking incident involving a live chicken at a Rustenburg lounge has sparked outrage and led to an animal cruelty case being opened at the Tlhabane Police Station.

A video that recently surfaced online allegedly shows a man swinging a live chicken by its legs and pouring what appears to be beer over the terrified animal in a packed club environment.

According to the Rustenburg SPCA, they were made aware of the footage and immediately launched an investigation.

“The Rustenburg SPCA condemns this disturbing act in the strongest terms. Animal cruelty is not entertainment — it is an offence. We’ve opened a docket, and the matter is now in the hands of law enforcement,” Mthunzi Kunene, manager of the Rustenburg SPCA, said.

The SPCA urges the public to treat all animals with dignity and to report any acts of cruelty. If you have any information that may assist with this investigation, please contact the Rustenburg SPCA or Tlhabane Police.

## Copper thief gets 16 years for targeting mine infrastructure

**Rustenburg** – A 54-year-old Mozambican national, John Paipai Sithole, has been sentenced to 16 years in prison by the Tlhabane Regional Court after being caught stealing copper cables from Impala Bafokeng Mine in February 2025.

Sithole received 15 years for tampering with essential infrastructure and one year for being in the country illegally. The court heard how the theft caused major disruptions to operations and financial losses.


The NPA welcomed the ruling, calling it a firm stand against crimes that threaten economic stability and community livelihoods.

## BAIL DENIED FOR ACCUSED IN KOSTER DOUBLE MURDER

**Rustenburg** – Bail has been denied for the two men accused of murdering George William Koster (68) and Wilma Reinet Koster (65), who were senselessly gunned down at Platinum Square Shopping Centre on Saturday, 14 June 2025.

The pair appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrate’s Court on Tuesday, 14 July 2025, where the magistrate ruled that both accused would remain in custody until their next court appearance, scheduled for Thursday, 4 September 2025.

This comes after an intense investigation by SAPS that led to their arrest. One suspect allegedly admitted to being the getaway driver, while the second reportedly confessed to pulling the trigger, later directing authorities to the firearm and his co-accused in Rustenburg East.

## Traditional Healer Gets 14 Years for Rape

**Tlhabane** – A man who claimed to be a traditional healer has been sentenced to 14 years in prison for the rape and assault of his girlfriend in Meriting, near Rustenburg. Joseph Madubula Mnisi (46) was convicted in the Bafokeng Regional Court on Thursday, 10 July 2025, following a disturbing incident that occurred in February last year. Mnisi arrived in Meriting from Limpopo on 31 January 2024 with his 29-year-old girlfriend, allegedly to render healing services to a local family. Just two days later, after a day of heavy drinking, he violently assaulted her and raped her during the night.

The victim managed to flee the next morning while Mnisi was asleep. She found help from street vendors nearby, who immediately contacted the police. Mnisi was arrested on the spot. Detective sergeant Pheno Monchusi from the Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences (FCS) Unit took over the case. Thanks to her thorough investigation, bail was denied and Mnisi remained behind bars throughout the trial.

Mnisi was found guilty on two counts of assault with intent to cause grievous bodily harm and one count of rape. He received five years for each assault charge and 14 years for the rape. The sentences will run concurrently.

Brigadier Joel Pheto, acting Bojanala Platinum Sub-District commissioner, praised the investigation and prosecution teams.

## CAUGHT AND CONVICTED

**Rustenburg** – Two Mozambican nationals were sentenced on Monday 14 July 2025 in separate cases for crimes committed in the Rustenburg area.

Edwardo Macambaco (25) was sentenced to 10 years for attempted murder after stabbing a man in the chest during an unprovoked altercation in Tlhabane in 2023. He also received six months for contravening the Immigration Act.

In a separate case, Phineas Mhlanga (22) was handed a seven-year sentence for tampering with essential infrastructure after being caught dismantling streetlights. He too received six months for immigration violations and will be deported after serving his time.

Brigadier Joel Pheto praised the dedicated police work that led to both convictions.

## TRAGIC END FOR DAVID MONESE

**NW** – The body of 59-year-old David Filmore Monese, who was reported missing from Mogwase at the end of June 2025, has been found — bringing a tragic end to the search and launching a murder investigation that has already resulted in one arrest.

Monese was last seen at work on Friday, 27 June 2025. Following the report of his disappearance, a 72-hour activation plan was swiftly executed by a multidisciplinary task team comprising Crime Intelligence, the Provincial Murder and Robbery Unit, Rustenburg Vehicle Crime Investigating Unit (VCIU), and Mogwase Detectives.

Thanks to their relentless efforts, 39-year-old Lucas Enock Mkhize was arrested on Monday, 7 July 2025, along the N18 road near Ramatlaba, where he was attempting to evade capture. Police then raided an address in Ramatlaba Six Hundred, where they confiscated several cellphones and clothing suspected to have been stolen. Mkhize later led police to Bangladesh Section in Hebron Village, where the decomposed body of Monese was discovered in an open field — tragically dumped after what appears to have been a violent murder.

The police immediately opened a case of murder in Hebron. Additional charges of kidnapping, house robbery, and carjacking were also filed at Mogwase Police Station. Mkhize has since appeared in the Ga-Rankuwa Magistrates’ Court and remains in custody. His next appearance is scheduled for Thursday, 24 July 2025.

The police are now intensifying their search for Mkhize’s alleged accomplices — identified only as Pontsho and MJ. The authorities warn that both men are considered armed and dangerous. The public is strongly urged not to engage with them, but to instead report any sightings or information to their nearest police station or anonymously via Crime Stop at 08600 10111 or the MySAPS app.

Major general Patrick Asaneng, acting provincial police commissioner of North West, condemned the crime in the strongest terms.

## Illegal Mining: Three Bodies Found Near Rustenburg Shaft

**Rustenburg** – The discovery of three bodies near an unused shaft and the arrest of four men have raised serious concerns over illegal mining activities in the North West. Three suspects — Danny Mashaba (35), Samson Machigera (33) and Raphael Movela (24) — are expected to make their second appearance in the Rustenburg Magistrate’s Court on Thursday, 24 July 2025, following their arrest for trespassing at Sibanye-Stillwater’s Operation Belt 4 shaft in Marikana.

Their first court appearance took place on 10 July 2025, two days after mine security responded to an alarm and caught a group of people attempting to exit the closed shaft, which has been out of operation since March 2024. On being confronted, the group fled back underground — leaving behind three deceased men tied to makeshift stretchers. Out of four suspects apprehended, two were taken to hospital. One has since been discharged and detained; the other remains under police guard. Police have opened an inquest into the deaths, and the victims are yet to be identified.

Acting provincial police commissioner major general Patrick Asaneng has since ordered a multi-

disciplinary operation at the site. “This incident, coming so soon after the tragedy at Stilfontein’s Buffelsfontein Gold Mine, is deeply troubling. It’s becoming clear that what happened there was just the tip of the iceberg.”

He warned of a growing crisis tied to the illegal economy, stating that illegal chrome mining and related crimes are spreading to Mooienooi, Tlhatlaganye, Tweelagte, Witrandjie, Masebudi near Zeerust, and even Ottoshoop outside Mahikeng.

Police efforts under Operation Vala Umgodi have made strides in stabilising parts of the gold sector, particularly in the Dr Kenneth Kaunda District, but the rise in illegal chrome activity in other regions calls for urgent and unified action.

The Department of Mineral Resources and Energy has been contacted, as many of these incidents stem from community disputes over land and mining rights. “We need all key stakeholders — traditional leaders, government departments, law enforcement, and communities — to work together to address the root causes,” Asaneng concluded. The investigation continues.

Application for an alternative emissions limit for sulphur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) in terms of Regulation 12a of the Minimum Emission Standards (MES) of 22 November 2013 as amended, published in terms of Section 21 of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act 39 of 2004

Impala Platinum Holdings Limited operates a major platinum group metals (PGM) mining and processing facility located in Rustenburg, North West Province. In accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act, 2004 (Act No. 39 of 2004) (NEMAQAA), the Rustenburg Operations (Impala) must comply with its Atmospheric Emission Licence (AEL). This licence mandates adherence to the Minimum Emission Standards (MES), as outlined in the "List of Activities Which Result in Atmospheric Emissions Which Have or May Have a Significant Detimental Effect on the Environment, Including Health, Social Conditions, Economic Conditions, Ecological Conditions or Cultural Heritage" (Government Notice No. 893, Government Gazette No. 37054 of 22 November 2013). The MES prescribes specific emission limits and operational requirements for listed activities associated with mining and metallurgical processing.

The National Air Quality Officer (NAQO) granted Impala, postponement for MES compliance for particulate matter (PM) emissions from spray drying and sulphur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) emissions from the Tailgas

Scrubber (TGS) until 31 December 2024. Impala used that postponement to reduce PM emissions to comply with the new plant limits. However, Impala could not consistently achieve the SO<sub>2</sub> emissions compliance limits for its TGS – which is regulated in the MES under subcategory 4.16 Smelting and Converting of Sulphide Ores. Accordingly, Impala Platinum intends to apply to the NAQO for an alternative emissions limit for SO<sub>2</sub> in terms of Regulation 12A of the MES. This application seeks to ensure the continued lawful operation of the Impala facility, while the implementation of the long-term compliance solution is finalised and sustained regulatory compliance is achieved.

Impala will submit a Motivation Report together with an Atmospheric Impact Report (AIR) in support of the Regulation 12A application in accordance with all applicable regulatory requirements. The AIR will undertake an independent and objective analysis of the potential impact of the application on ambient air quality. Additionally, Impala will undertake a public participation process to enable any Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) to review and comment on

the application. Air Resource Management (Pty) Ltd (ARM), an independent environmental consultancy, has been appointed together with suitably qualified specialists from Airshed Planning Professionals (Pty) Ltd to prepare the application and oversee the associated public participation process. The formal announcement of the application, along with the commencement of the Interested and Affected Parties (I&AP) registration process, is scheduled for 18 July 2025.

The announcement of the application and opening of the associated I&AP registration process will commence on 18 July 2025. Background information on the application will be included in the announcement and Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) are encouraged to register as soon as possible for public participation on the application. The registration period will continue to run concurrently with the review and commenting period of the Draft AIR and Motivation Report which will be available for 30 calendar days (excluding public holidays) from 1 August to 31 August 2025 for I&AP review and comments.

## DA calls for urgent plan to save Olympia Park Stadium

**Rustenburg** — “The Democratic Alliance (DA) is calling on the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) to urgently implement a turnaround plan for the crumbling Olympia Park Stadium. This follows Orbit College FC’s decision to host its premier division home games at the Royal Bafokeng Stadium instead,” said DA councillor Nelio Nhacuanguue.

“While this stadium is located within Rustenburg, it is not owned or managed by the municipality, resulting in a direct and measurable loss of revenue, opportunity, and public value for the Rustenburg Local Municipality,” clrr Nhacuanguue added.

The DA had raised concerns about the stadium’s poor condition as early as November 2023. With the venue now declared non-compliant by South African Football Association (SAFA), it can no longer host professional football — a blow to local pride and economic potential.

Local residents have also voiced concern. “I regularly go to the stadium to run and exercise. I take my dog along, and on weekends, my siblings and friends join me,” one reader shared. “When there are matches, we buy food and enjoy the day. I hope this doesn’t go away — that community feeling is something special.”

The DA is urging RLM to:

- Conduct full safety and structural checks
- Develop a repair and compliance plan
- Create a rental strategy for events and functions
- Set deadlines and assign responsibility

“Olympia Park shouldn’t be a white elephant,” said Nhacuanguue. “It should be a hub of sport, jobs, and community events.”

No response was received from the municipality by the time of publication.


## "No time to waste" – Hyacinth emergency at Vaalkop Dam

**Vaalkop Dam, North West** – Deputy minister of Water and Sanitation, Sello Seitholo, has committed to eradicating the invasive plant infestation at Vaalkop Dam.

During a two-day oversight visit (27–28 June 2025), Seitholo announced the formation of a multi-stakeholder working group to tackle the aggressive spread of water hyacinth and Salvinia minima, which threaten water treatment operations and regional supply.

"I am taking personal responsibility to ensure the infestation is eradicated," said Seitholo. "Pollution and negligence must stop crippling our water systems." He also plans to propose that water pollution be declared a **national crisis**, to unlock the resources and urgency needed to address the growing threat.

The infestation is worsened by untreated sewage, agricultural runoff, urban waste, and mining pollution — all feeding the weed growth. The deputy minister warned that municipalities failing to manage wastewater will face consequences. The working group will include the Department of



Water and Sanitation, Magalies Water, affected municipalities, and environmental experts. Their task: assess the damage and implement urgent recovery plans. Seitholo's intervention forms part of a broader push to restore South Africa's water infrastructure and crack down on pollution.

Water hyacinth, one of the world's most invasive aquatic weeds, blankets sections of Vaalkop Dam, threatening regional water supply and biodiversity.


